PAJARITA WILDERNESS AREA

A tract of land within the Administrative Boundary of the Coronado National Forest in Santa Cruz County, Arizona, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the corner common to sections 13, 14 23, and 24 of Township 23 South, Range 11 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian;

Thence south on the section line between sections 23 and 24, Township 23 South, Range 11 East, approximately 0.75 mile to the S1/16 corner of sections 23 and 24, Township 23 South, Range 11 East;

Thence easterly on the latitudinal centerline of the SW1/4 of section 24, Township 23 South, Range 11 East, approximately 0.11 mile to the center of Atascosa Canyon;

Thence south and southwesterly approximately 0.75 miles along Atascosa Canyon, to the junction with Penasco Canyon;

Thence southeasterly along Penasco Canyon approximately 1.1 miles to a point at sharp bend in canyon, running west to south;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.16 miles to a knob with a contour elevation of 4260 feet;

Thence east approximately 0.12 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 4260 feet;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.35 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 4400 feet, being the first knob west of Rattlesnake Tank;

Thence easterly approximately 0.47 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 4720 feet;

Thence southeasterly approximately 0.95 mile to a knob with shown elevation of 4624 feet;

Thence southerly approximately 0.87 mile to a point 200 feet west of Forest Road 39A, on a spur bearing northwesterly, with a contour elevation of 4840 feet;

Thence northwesterly along same spur approximately 0.57 mile to a fork of Penasco Canyon;

Thence westerly along Penasco Canyon approximately 0.17 mile to a fork of Penasco Canyon;

Thence southwesterly approximately 0.50 mile, along a ridge, to a point 30 feet north of the end of Forest Development Road 4189;

Thence northwesterly approximately 0.09 miles to a knob with a contour elevation of 4680 feet;

Thence southerly approximately 1.12 miles to a point 100 feet west of the centerline of Forest Development Road 39A where it intersects with Trail No. 40;

Thence southerly, parallel with and 100 feet west of Forest Development Road 39A, to a point on the northern line of the 60 foot International Boundary Reservation created by proclamation of May 27, 1907;

Thence North 69 degrees 22 minutes West on said International Boundary Reservation line approximately 4.12 miles to a point on a southeast divide of Flat Top Mountain;

Thence northwesterly approximately 0.15 mile, along same divide, to Flat Top Mountain, with a shown elevation of 4222 feet;

Thence northerly approximately 0.40 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 3880 feet;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.28 mile to a point with a shown elevation of 4114 feet;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.21 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 4040 feet;

Thence north approximately 0.25 mile to a knob with a contour elevation of 4200 feet;

Thence northerly approximately 0.53 mile to a point on the east side of a flat area, with a contour elevation of 4200 feet;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.19 mile to southwest tip of spur, with a contour elevation of 4280 feet;

Thence northeasterly approximately 0.40 mile to a point on north end of peak, with a contour elevation of 4640 feet;

Thence northerly along Mule Ridge approximately 1.5 miles to a point on a southeast end of slope, with a contour elevation of 4680 feet, and approximately 300 feet east of the section line between sections 15 and 16, Township 23 South, Range 11 East;

Thence easterly approximately 0.60 mile to a point 100 feet south of the southerly most point on the centerline of Forest Development Road 4180;

Thence southeasterly approximately 0.70 mile to a point on Trail # 40;

Thence southeasterly approximately 0.85 miles to a knob with a with a contour elevation of 4240 feet, being on the section line between sections 13 and 14, Township 23 South, Range 11 East;

Thence South on said section line 0.16 mile to the Point of Beginning.

Lands herein described and topographic features referred to are depicted on 7.5 minute Forest Service Primary Base Maps: RUBY, ARIZ.-SONORA (1981), ALAMO SPRING, ARIZ.-SONORA (1980).

These quadrangle sheets are intended to be an integral part of the legal description. The total area of the Pajarita Wildneress Area is 7,464 Acres, more or less.
