WET BEAVER WILDERNESS
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST

Wet Beaver Wilderness as established by the Arizona Wilderness Act of 1984, public law 98-406, described as a tract of land within the administrative boundaries of the Coconino National Forest in Yavapai and Coconino Counties, State of Arizona, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the corner of Sections 13, 18, 19, and 24, T. 15 N., R. 7 E., and R. 8 E.;

Thence, Westerly along a precipice above Wet Beaver Creek, approximately 1.7 miles to a point on a small ridge;

Thence, Westerly along a ridge approximately 0.1 miles to a point in a drainage that runs northerly;

Thence, Westerly along a ridge approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;

Thence, Westerly along a precipice approximately 1.1 miles to a point in a drainage which lies 0.2 miles easterly of a fork in a drainage;

Thence, Westerly along a precipice approximately 0.2 miles to a point in a drainage which runs northerly and lies approximately 0.1 miles southerly of a fork in a drainage;

Thence, Northwesterly along a precipice approximately 2.1 miles to a point on a ridge that bears northwesterly;

Thence, Southerly approximately 0.1 miles to a point in a drainage which runs westerly;

Thence, Southerly approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;

Thence, Westerly along a precipice approximately 0.5 miles;

Thence, Southeasterly along said precipice approximately 0.7 miles to a point in a draw;

Thence, Southerly along said draw approximately 0.1 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.5 miles east of a fork in a drainage;

WET BEAVER WILDERNESS continued

- Thence, Southerly along a ridge approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Along a precipice approximately 1.9 miles to a point on a small ridge;
- Thence, Southerly approximately 0.1 miles to a point in a drainage;
- Thence, Continuing southerly approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Westerly along said precipice approximately 2.0 miles to a point on Bell Trail (Trail No. 13);
- Thence, Continuing along a precipice, above Long Canyon, approximately 2.7 miles to a point that lies in a draw;
- Thence, Southerly approximately 0.1 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.3 miles west of a fork in said drainage;
- Thence, Westerly along a precipice, which is coincidental with the 5,400 foot contour, approximately 0.5 miles to a point on the easterly side of a ridge that bears northwesterly;
- Thence, Along the easterly side of said ridge approximately 0.3 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Southerly along a precipice approximately 0.8 miles to a point that lies 33 feet westerly of Long Canyon Trail, Trail No. 63;
- Thence, Southwesterly along a line parallel to and 33 feet westerly of said trail across a drainage approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Northerly along said precipice, above Long Canyon, approximately 3.2 miles to a point which lies on a precipice above Wet Beaver Creek, which is coincidental with the 4,800 foot contour;
- Thence, Westerly along the precipice above Wet Beaver Creek, also being the 4,800 foot contour, approximately 0.5 miles to a point which lies on a ridge that bears northwesterly;
- Thence, Southerly along said precipice approximately 0.5 miles to a point in a drainage;
- Thence, Northwesterly along the precipice approximately 1.1 miles to a point on a ridge;

WET BEAVER WILDERNESS continued

- Thence, Northeasterly along said ridge approximately 0.3 miles to a point which lies 33 feet southerly of Wet Beaver Creek;
- Thence, Easterly along a line parallel to and 33 feet southerly of Wet Beaver Creek approximately 0.2 miles to a point which lies 33 feet southeasterly of the gaging station;
- Thence, Westerly along a line parallel to and 33 feet northerly of Wet Beaver Creek approximately 0.3 miles to a point which lies 100 feet from Road 656;
- Thence, Westerly along a line parallel to and 100 feet northerly of Road 656 approximately 0.7 miles to a point in a draw that bears northwesterly;
- Thence, Northwesterly along the center of a draw approximately 0.3 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Northeasterly along said precipice, above Casner Canyon, approximately 1.8 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.4 miles northerly of a fork in a drainage;
- Thence, Southerly along said precipice approximately 0.6 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.4 miles easterly of a fork in a drainage;
- Thence, Continuing along said precipice approximately 0.9 miles to a point on Apache Maid Trail (Trail No. 15);
- Thence, Mostly easterly along said precipice approximately 4.9 miles to a point on a small ridge;
- Thence, Easterly along said ridge approximately 0.08 miles to a point in a drainage;
- Thence, Easterly along a ridge approximately 0.1 miles to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, North $77^{\circ}05'$ East, 82 feet;
- Thence, South $64^{\circ}40'$ East, 318 feet to a point on top of a ridge, bears North and Southeast, said point approximately 700 feet southerly from the confluence of two unnamed drainages;
- Thence, South $39^{\circ}06'$ West, 292 feet;
- Thence, South $46^{\circ}05'$ West, 170 feet;

WET BEAVER WILDERNESS continued

- Thence, South $49^{\circ}27'$ West, 241 feet;
- Thence, South $49^{\circ}05'$ West, 269 feet;
- Thence, South $55^{\circ}15'$ West, 222 feet;
- Thence, South $58^{\circ}11'$ West, 202 feet;
- Thence, South $63^{\circ}21'$ West, 214 feet to a point on a precipice;
- Thence, Continuing southerly along said precipice approximately 2.0 miles to a point on a ridge which bears westerly;
- Thence, Easterly along a precipice, above Wet Beaver Creek, approximately 6.0 miles to a point in a drainage which runs southerly;
- Thence, Mostly southerly along said precipice approximately 1.3 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.6 miles northeasterly of the junction of said drainage and Wet Beaver Creek;
- Thence, Mostly easterly along a precipice approximately 1.3 miles to a point in a drainage, which lies approximately 0.5 miles northerly of the fork of said drainage and Wet Beaver Creek;
- Thence, Southerly along a precipice northeasterly of Wet Beaver Creek approximately 2.0 miles to a point on a ridge that lies on the boundary between Beaver Creek and Long Valley Ranger Districts;
- Thence, Mostly northerly along said district boundaries, also being a precipice, approximately 2.1 miles;
- Thence, North $72^{\circ}41'$ East, 50 feet;
- Thence, South $78^{\circ}31'$ East, 112 feet;
- Thence, South $72^{\circ}52'$ East, 73 feet;
- Thence, South $25^{\circ}26'$ East, 22 feet;
- Thence, South $06^{\circ}02'$ East, 50 feet to a point on a precipice on the east side of wet Beaver Creek;
- Thence, Southerly along said precipice approximately 0.4 miles to a point on a ridge which bears southwesterly;

WET BEAVER WILDERNESS continued

Thence, Mostly easterly along a precipice, above Brady Canyon, approximately 1.3 miles;

Thence, South 01°05' West, 340 feet to a point on a precipice;

Thence, Westerly along said precipice, above Brady Canyon, approximately 1.3 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.1 miles northwesterly of a fork in said drainage;

Thence, Continuing westerly along said precipice approximately 2.2 miles to a point in a drainage which lies approximately 0.1 miles southerly of the junction of said drainage and Wet Beaver Creek;

Thence, Continuing northwesterly along said precipice approximately 1.2 miles to the corner of Sections 13, 18, 19 and 24, T. 15 N., R. 7 E., and R. 8 E., the Point of Beginning.

Lands herein described and topographic features referred to are depicted on 7 1/2 minute United States Geological Survey Quadrangle Sheets, Casner Butte and Apache Maid Mountain, dated 1984. The Quadrangle Sheets are intended to be an integral part of the legal description. The total area of the Wet Beaver Wilderness is 6,183 acres, more or less.
