Boundary Description

The Hauser Wilderness is located in the Cleveland National Forest, in the County of San Diego, State of California. The following description refers to the attached map titled "Hauser Wilderness", dated February, 1987.

In Township 17 South, Range 4 East, San Bernardino Meridian

Beginning at the corner of Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26;

thence Southerly approximately 3960 feet to the S 1/16 corner of Sections 25 and 26;

thence Westerly approximately 1300 feet along the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, to a point lying 300 feet distant radially from the centerline and on the North side of Forest Service Road 17S07 connecting Hauser Canyon and Lake Morena road;

thence Northwesterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the North side of Forest Service Road 17S07, approximately 19000 feet to a point South of the E-W 1/64 corner between Sections 20 and 17;

thence Northerly approximately 1800 feet to the E-W 1/64 corner between Sections 20 and 17;

thence South 89° 17' West 1949 feet to the Northwest corner of Section 20;

thence North 89° 35' West 1965 feet along the North line of Section 19 to the W-E 1/64 corner between Sections 18 and 19;

thence Southwesterly to a point lying South of the quarter corner between Sections 18 and 19 and 300 feet distant radially from Forest Service road 17S07;

thence Northwesterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the North side of Forest Service Road 17S07, approximately 800 feet to a point in Cottonwood Creek lying 300 feet distant radially and on the Northeast side of the intersection of Forest Service Road 17S07 and a trail;

thence Northwesterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the North side of said trail, approximately 2500 feet to the Section line between Section 19, T.17S., R.4E., and Section 24, T.17S., R.3E.;

In Township 17 South, Range 3 East, San Bernardino Meridian

thence Northwesterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the North side of said trail approximately 17500 feet, to a point lying 300 feet distant radially from the centerline and on the East side of Forest Service Road 17S07, said point being in the Northwest Quarter of Section 15;

thence Northerly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the East side of Forest Service Road 17S07, approximately 6000 feet to a point lying 300 feet distant radially from the intersection of the centerlines of Forest Service Road 17S07 and Forest Service Road 17S06;

thence Northerly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the East side of Forest Service Road 17S06, approximately 5000 feet to the Section line between Sections 2 and 3;

thence Easterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the South side of Forest Service Road 17S06, approximately 15500 feet to the Section line between Section 1, T.17S., R.3E., and Section 6, T.17S., R.4E.;

In Township 17 South, Range 4 East, San Bernardino Meridian

thence Easterly and Southerly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the South and West side of Forest Service Road 17S06, approximately 6000 feet to the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7;

thence South $89^{\circ} 57'$ West, approximately 2000 feet to the N-W 1/16 corner of Section 7;

thence South $0^{\circ} 23'$ West approximately 1320 feet to the C-W 1/16 corner of Section 7;

thence South, approximately 1320 feet to the SW 1/16 corner of Section 7;

thence North $89^{\circ} 38'$ East, approximately 2640 feet to the SE 1/16 corner of Section 7;

thence North, approximately 1320 feet to the C-E 1/16 corner of Section 7;

thence North $0^{\circ} 25'$ East, approximately 900 feet along the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, to a point lying 300 feet distant radially from the centerline and on the South side of Forest Service Road 16S17 connecting Stokes Valley and Bronco Flats;

thence Southeasterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the South side of Forest Service road 16S17, approximately 14000 feet to a point on the boundary of Tract 52 between Angle Points 2 and 3 of said Tract;

thence South $0^{\circ} 07'$ West, approximately 600 feet to Angle point 3 of Tract 52;

thence West, 1323 feet to Angle Point 4 of Tract 52;

thence South, 1320 to Angle Point 5 of Tract 52;

thence West 1980 feet to a point;

thence South 2590 feet to a point;

thence East 660 feet to angle point 3 of tract 53;

thence East 1320 feet to angle point 4 of tract 53;

thence North $0^{\circ} 01'$ West 1427 feet to the Northwest corner of Section 22;

thence South $89^{\circ} 49'$ East 3967 feet to a point on the North line of Section 22 which lies South of Angle point 6 of Tract 52;

thence North approximately 2000 feet to a point 300 feet distant radially from the centerline and on the South side of Forest Service Road 16S17;

thence Southeasterly, 300 feet distant from the centerline and on the South side of Forest Service road 16S17, approximately 2000 feet to a point lying 300 feet distant radially and on the South side of the intersection of the centerlines of Forest Service Road 16S17 and a dirt road to Morena Dam;

thence Southeasterly, 300 feet distant from and on the South side of the centerline of the dirt road to Morena Dam, approximately 2000 feet to a point at the intersection with the 3200 foot contour;

thence Southerly along the 3200 foot contour to a point North of the center quarter corner of Section 23;

thence South to the center quarter corner of Section 23;

thence Southeasterly to the NE-SE $1/64$ corner of Section 23;

thence Southeasterly to the S-S $1/64$ corner of Section 23;

thence Southerly along the Section line between Sections 23 and 24 to the corner of Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, T.17S., R4E., being the point of beginning.

The foregoing description is shown on the attached 1-inch-equals-1 mile scale map.

contains approximately 8,195 acres, of which approximately 544 are private lands and 7,651 are National Forest System lands.
