Boundary Description

The North Fork Wilderness is located in the Six Rivers National Forest, Humboldt County, State of California. This description refers to the boundary shown on the attached map entitled "North Fork Wilderness", and dated 10-25-84.

Commencing at a point on the section line common to Sections 9 and 10, T.4S., R.7E., H.M., 330 feet northerly of the centerline of Trinity County Road #520;

thence, easterly, northeasterly and southerly along a line 330 feet northerly and easterly of and parallel to the centerline of said road to a point on the southerly boundary of the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 14, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence northeasterly, crossing the high point of a ridge in the NE1/4NW1/4 of Section 14, T.4S., R.7E., and beyond to the quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 14, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the SW1/4SE1/4, Section 11, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, easterly to the NE corner of the SW1/4SE1/4, Section 11, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly to the SE corner of the SW1/4SE1/4, Section 11, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, easterly to the corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly to the quarter corner common to Sections 13 and 14, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southeasterly to a point on the westerly edge of a trail to the Willie Hoaglin Place, said point also being on the section line common to Sections 13 and 24, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, easterly to the NW corner of the NE1/4NE1/4, Section 24, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly to the SW corner of the SE1/4NE1/4, Section 24, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, easterly to the quarter corner common to Sections 19 and 24, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly to the SE1/4 corner of the NE1/4NE1/4, Section 25, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, westerly along the south boundary of the N1/2NE1/4, Section 25, T.4S., R.7E., to a point 330 feet easterly of Trinity County Road #520;

thence, southerly along a line 330 feet easterly of and parallel to Trinity County Road #520 to a point on the section line common to Sections 25 and 36, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, easterly to the section corner common to Sections 25 and 35, T.4S., R.7E., and Sections 30 and 31, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, southerly to the SW corner of the NW1/4NW1/4 of Section 31, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, easterly to a point in the SW1/4NE1/4, Section 31, T.4S., R.8E., approximately 330 feet easterly of the North Fork of the Eel River.

thence, southeasterly approximately 990 feet to the centerline of the North Fork of the Eel River in the SW1/4NE1/4, Section 31, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northeasterly along a minor ridge to the SE corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 29, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the SW corner of the SE1/4SW1/4NW1/4, Section 29, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to a point on the southern boundary of the SW1/4SE1/4NW1/4, Section 29, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the NE1/4NW1/4, Section 29, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, easterly to the quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 29, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence northerly to the SE corner of the NE1/4NW1/4, Section 20, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the SW corner of the NE1/4NW1/4, Section 20, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NE corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the NW corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, southerly to the section corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19, and 20, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the SW corner of the SE1/4SE1/4, Section 18, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the NE1/4SE1/4, Section 18, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence westerly to the center of Section 18, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the SW1/4NE1/4, Section 18, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, easterly to the NW corner of the SW1/4NW1/4, Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, southerly to the quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 18, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, easterly to the center of Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NE corner of the SE1/4NW1/4, Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the NW corner of the SE1/4NW1/4, Section 17, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NE corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 8, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the NW corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 8, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the SE corner of the NE1/4NE1/4, Section 7, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the SW corner of the NE1/4NE1/4, Section 7, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the SE corner of the NW1/4NE1/4, Section 7, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the SW corner of the SE1/4NW1/4NE1/4, Section 6, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the NW1/4NW1/4NE1/4, Section 6, T.4S., R.8E.;

thence, westerly to the NE corner of the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 1, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly to the SE corner of the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 1, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, westerly to the SE corner of the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 2, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, northerly to the NE corner of the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 2, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, westerly to the section corner common to Sections 2 and 3, T.4S., R.7E., and Sections 34 and 35, T.3S., R.7E.;

thence, northerly to the NW corner of the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 35, T.3S., R.7E., said point being 330 feet southerly of the centerline of a four-wheel drive road;

thence, westerly along a line 330 feet south and east of and parallel to the centerline of the four-wheel drive road to a point of intersection with the section line common to Sections 9 and 10, T.4S., R.7E.;

thence, southerly along the section line common to Sections 9 and 10, T.4S., R.7E., to the point of beginning.
