
NEVER SUMMER WILDERNESS ADDITION

The boundary description and final map herewith, titled "Never Summer Wilderness Addition", dated September 2, 2015, delineate the location of the boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness Addition, on the Arapaho National Forest, as entered into the National Wilderness Preservation System under the Colorado Wilderness Act of 1993, Public Law 103-77, dated August 13, 1993. The boundary description and final map conform to the boundary as generally depicted on the Legislative Map cited by Congress in Public Law 103-77.



NEVER SUMMER WILDERNESS ADDITION OF 1993  
Arapaho National Forest

Boundary Description

BEGINNING at a summit on Blue Ridge with an elevation of 11,686 feet, on the original boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness, in the southeast 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian;

thence northeasterly along said original Wilderness boundary 6.0 miles, more or less, to the section line between Sections 35 and 36, Township 5 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian, also being the boundary of Arapaho National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park;

thence southerly along said section line 0.7 mile, more or less, to the First Standard Parallel North also being the Range Line between Townships 4 and 5 North, Sixth Principal Meridian;

thence westerly along said First Standard Parallel North 0.1 mile, more or less, to the north 1/4 corner of Section 2, Township 4 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian;

thence southerly along the N-S centerline of Section 2, 1 mile, more or less, to the 1/4 corner between Sections 2 and 11;

thence southerly along the N-S centerline of Section 11, 1 mile, more or less, to the 1/4 corner between Sections 11 and 14;

thence southerly, leaving the Arapaho National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park boundary, along the N-S centerline of Section 14, 0.2 mile, more or less, to the north mean high water line of an unnamed easterly flowing stream;

thence westerly along the north mean high water line of said stream 1.6 miles, more or less, to a point 75 feet east of and parallel to the centerline of FDR 120.5;

thence northwesterly along said road offset line 1.5 miles, more or less, to a point approximately at UTM coordinates: E: 422865, N: 4463915;

thence southeast less than 0.1 mile to a point on a line 75 feet south of and parallel to the centerline of FDR 120.5 at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 422840, N: 4463875;

thence southwesterly 0.1 mile, more or less, to a point on the 10,600 foot contour at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 422760, N: 4463740;

thence westerly following the 10,600 foot contour 1.0 mile, more or less, to the thread of an unnamed easterly flowing stream;

thence westerly along the thread of said stream 0.3 mile, more or less, to a point at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 421110, N: 4463595;

thence westerly 0.4 mile, more or less, to a point on the hydrographic divide of Blue Ridge, at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 420540, N: 4463500;

thence northwesterly along said hydrographic divide of Blue Ridge 0.4 mile, more or less, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

AND

BEGINNING at a summit on Blue Ridge with an elevation of 11,686 feet, on the original boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness, in the southeast 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of Section 7, Township 4 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian;

thence westerly 3.0 miles, more or less, to the confluence of two unnamed creeks at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 415525, N: 4464965;

thence northerly along the east high water line of the westernmost of said two streams 2.4 miles, more or less, to a point at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 416280, N: 4468215;

thence easterly 0.2 mile, more or less, to a point on the Continental Divide at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 416570, N: 4468250;

thence southeasterly along the Continental Divide, which is the boundary between the Routt and Arapaho National Forests, also being the boundary between Grand and Jackson Counties, 1.8 miles, more or less, to a summit with an elevation of 12,198 feet on the original boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness;

thence southeasterly, leaving the Continental Divide and said Forest and County boundaries, along said original Never Summer Wilderness boundary, 2.2 miles, more or less, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

AND

BEGINNING at the point of intersection of the original boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness and the section line between Sections 25 and 26, Township 5 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian, also being on the boundary between Arapaho National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park;

thence northwesterly along said original Never Summer Wilderness boundary, also being the hydrographic divide between Baker Gulch and the Colorado River, 0.5 miles, more or less, to a point of intersection with the 300 foot southerly offset line of the Grand Ditch

access road as described in the original of description of the Exterior Boundary of the Never Summer Wilderness, dated April 28, 1982, at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 4257705, N: 4468705;

thence easterly less than 0.1 mile to a point on a line 100 feet west of and parallel to the centerline of the Grand Ditch Access Road at approximate UTM coordinates: E: 425770, N: 4468705;

thence easterly along said road offset line 0.6 mile, more or less, to the boundary of Arapaho National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park also being a portion of the section line between Sections 25 and 26, Township 5 North, Range 76 West, Sixth Principal Meridian;

thence southerly along said Arapaho National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park boundary and a portion of said section line 0.7 miles, more or less, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
