BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

BRADWELL BAY WILDERNESS

The Bradwell Bay Wilderness is located on the Apalachicola National Forest, Wakulla County, Florida, and is more particularly described as that land enclosed by the following line:

The Bradwell Bay Area is more specifically located in Townships 3 South and 4 South, Ranges 3 West and 4 West, Tallahassee Meridian.

Beginning at Bench Mark (B.M.) No. 49 located in Section 30, T.4S., R.3W., a 6" x 6" concrete monument with a brass cap, established by the U.S.G.S. in 1942, said monument being located 30 feet northerly of the center line of Forest Development Road (FDR) 329, approximate Latitude $30^{\circ}07'$ N, and Longitude $84^{\circ}34'$ W.;

thence in a generally northwesterly direction parallel to and 66 feet north of the center line of FDR 329, passing through Sections 30 and 19, T.4S., R.3W.; and into Section 24, T.4S., R.4W. a distance of approximately 0.889 mile;

thence changing the distance from 66 feet to 100 feet east of the center line of the road approximately a distance of 0.019 mile;

thence returning to 66 feet east of the center line and running 66 feet east of and parallel to the centerline of FDR 329 through Sections 24 and 23, T.4S., R.4W. a total distance of 1.592 miles, to a point 66 feet north and 66 feet east of the center line of the intersection of FDR 329 and FDR 344-3;

thence northerly passing through Sections 14, 11, 10, 2 and 3 of T.4S., R.4W.; and Sections 34 and 27 of T.3S., R.4W., 66 feet east of and parallel to FDR 344-3 a total distance of approximately 5.350 miles to a point 66 feet east of FDR 344-3 and 66 feet south of Forest Highway (FH) 13;

thence in a northeasterly direction 66 feet south of and parallel to the centerline of FH 13 passing through Sections 22, 23, 24, and 13, T.3S., R.4W. and entering T.3S., R.3W., Sections 18, 17, and 16, approximately 5.550 miles to a point 66 feet south of FH 13 and 66 feet west of FDR 347-1;

thence in a southeasterly direction 66 feet west of and parallel to the center line of FDR 347-1 passing through Sections 16, 21, 22, 27, 26, and 35, T.3S., R.3W. and into T.4S., R.3W. into Section 2 for an approximate total distance of 5.238 miles to a point 66 feet west of the intersection of FDR 347-1 and FDR 329;

thence in a southwesterly direction 66 feet north of and parallel to FDR 329, passing through Sections 2, 3, and 10, T.4S., R.3W., a total distance of approximately 2.654 miles to a point, 66 feet north and west of the intersection of FDR 329 and FDR 346-1;

thence continuing from Section 10 through Sections 9 and 16 and into Section 21, T.4S., R.3W., 66 feet north of and parallel to the centerline of FDR 329, approximately 3.300 miles, to a point 66 feet north of the intersection of FDR 329 and FDR 346-B;

thence in a westerly direction, 66 feet north of and parallel to FDR 329, passing from Section 21 into Sections 20, 19, and 30, T.4S., R.3W. approximately 2.385 miles, to a point, 66 feet north and east of the intersection of FDR 329 and FDR 345-1;

thence in a northerly direction, 66 feet east of and parallel to the center line of FDR 329, in Section 30, approximately 0.349 mile to the point of beginning.

This tract contains approximately 23,432 acres, more or less, as determined by digitizing from the U.S.G.S. map accompanying this description.
