

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION  
LEAF WILDERNESS AREA

The Leaf Wilderness Area is located entirely within Greene County, Mississippi, the DeSoto National Forest, Township One North, Range Eight West (T1N, R8W) of the St. Stephens Meridian, and is more particularly described as follows:

All of Section Twenty-seven (S 27); and all that part of the East one-half of the Northeast one-quarter of Section Thirty-three (E1/2NE1/4 S 33) and the North one-half of Section Thirty-four (N1/2 S 34) that lie North and East of the property boundary, as surveyed by C. W. Holmes of the U.S.D.A. Forest Service during January of 1935, and the G. M. and N. Railroad (presently the I.C.&G.), said property boundary and wilderness boundary lies 50 feet from and parallel to and along the North and East said of the following described Railroad centerline: Commence at the NW corner of the E1/2 of the NE1/4 of Section 33; thence East along and with the section line for 256.08 feet to the Railroad's centerline; thence S07°02'E for 1016.87 feet to a point; thence begin a 3° curve to the left with a central angle of 69°21' and a radius of 1909.86 feet, and following along and with the railroad centerline and this curve for a distance of 2,311.67 feet to the point of intersection with the South line of the N1/2 of Section 34.

The area being 994.26 acres, more or less, as determined from aliquot parts of GLO subdivisions and surveys. The area has been plotted on the attached map which is hereby made a part hereof.
