

TABLE MT. WILDERNESS LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The area included in the Table Mountain Wilderness is located within the Toiyabe National Forest, Intermountain Region and within Nye County, Nevada in accordance with the Nevada Wilderness Protection Act of 1989 (P.L. 101-195). The official boundary description and final maps are on file and available in the offices of the Forest Supervisor, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, Sparks, Nevada and the Regional Forester, Intermountain Region, Ogden, Utah. The Table Mountain Wilderness consists of an area of 92,600 acres, more or less, which was computed from 1:24,000 scale, 7 1/2 minute quadrangle maps using the Automated Lands Program Geographic Information System (GIS). A detailed description of the boundary follows:

Beginning at the corner for Section 31, T. 12 N., R. 49 E., and Section 6, T. 11 N., R. 49 E., on the range line of T. 11 N., R. 48 E., Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, (MDB&M);

thence southeasterly approximately 1,400 feet descending a ridge to a point at an elevation of 7,800 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 900 feet to a minor draw at an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,300 feet crossing CLEAR CREEK to a point in a draw with an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 3,900 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,400 feet;

thence westerly approximately 2,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,852 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,793 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,800 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,775 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,300 feet to a point in a draw with an elevation of 9,000 feet;

thence southerly approximately 1,800 feet ascending said draw to a point on a saddle with an approximate elevation of 9,620 feet;

thence southerly approximately 1,400 feet to a point in an unnamed tributary of SAWMILL CREEK with an elevation of 9000 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 3,300 feet descending said unnamed tributary to a point with an elevation of 8,200 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 5,600 feet crossing SAWMILL CREEK to a peak with an elevation of 9,403 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,600 feet along a ridge to a peak with an approximate elevation of 9,380 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 3,600 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,965 feet;

thence southerly approximately 2,200 feet crossing DANVILLE CANYON to a peak with an elevation of 8,701 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 3,700 feet to a point in an unnamed tributary of DANVILLE CREEK with an elevation of 8,040 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 4,100 feet ascending said unnamed tributary of DANVILLE CREEK to its confluence with a spring branch from the southwest at an approximate elevation of 8,420 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 1,700 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,930 feet;

thence S 80° E, approximately 3,200 feet to a point on a ridge line with an approximate elevation of 9,240 feet;

thence southerly approximately 2,000 feet along a ridge top to a peak with an elevation of 9,047 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,000 feet to the confluence of a drainage and GREEN MONSTER CANYON;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,800 feet to the corner of Sections 34 and 35, T. 11 N., R. 48 E., MDB&M;;

thence southerly approximately 2,700 feet to a knob on a ridge with an approximate elevation of 9,440 feet;

thence WEST, 3,100 feet to a point with an approximate elevation of 9,460 feet;

thence SOUTH approximately 3.5 miles to a point on a ridge with an approximate elevation of 7,960 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,300 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,050 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 500 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,020 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,200 feet to a point in an unnamed tributary of CLOVER CREEK with an elevation of 7,960 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 1,200 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,603 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 3,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,266 feet;

thence easterly approximately 2,200 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,611 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 3,100 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,640 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 3,600 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,760 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 1,800 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,800 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,100 feet to the confluence of two unnamed drainages in HORSE CANYON with an approximate elevation of 7,240 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 5,100 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,320 feet;

thence westerly approximately 700 feet to a saddle with an approximate elevation of 8,100 feet;

thence westerly approximately 2,200 feet along a ridge thru a peak with an elevation of 8,366 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,360 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,400 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,880 feet;

thence westerly approximately 2,400 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,800 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 3,200 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,440 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,600 feet to a point in a drainage with an elevation of 8,200 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 2,200 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,176 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 2,500 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,140 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 1,900 feet descending a ridge line thru a peak with an elevation of approximately 8,000 feet to a point at an elevation of 7,880 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,200 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,190 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 900 feet to a point in a drainage with an elevation of 7,720 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 200 feet descending a ridge to a point with an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence northwesterly and southwesterly approximately 7,400 feet along elevation 7,600 feet to a point in a unnamed drainage;

thence southwesterly approximately 400 feet ascending said draw to a low point on a saddle with an approximate elevation of 7,700 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 400 feet descending a draw to a point with an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 8,700 feet along elevation 7,600 feet to a point in an unnamed tributary of WILLOW CREEK;

thence southwesterly approximately 900 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,060 feet;

thence westerly approximately 2,800 feet ascending a ridge to a peak with an elevation of 8,842 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 3,300 feet to a minor knob with an approximate elevation of 8,320 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 3,200 feet to a point on a ridge with an elevation of 8,800 feet;

thence S. 28° W. approximately 3,700 feet to a point with an elevation of 7,800 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,100 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,920 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,600 feet to a peak with an elevation of 8,553 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 3,300 feet along a ridge to a peak with an elevation of 8,225 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,800 feet to a point in a drainage at an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 4,500 feet along elevation 7,600 feet to a point on a ridge;

thence approximately N. 60° E., 1,000 feet to a point on a ridge with an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,200 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,988 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,100 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,700 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 1,300 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 7,730 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,400 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,160 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 4,800 feet to a peak with an approximate elevation of 8,380 feet;

thence southerly approximately 900 feet descending said draw to a point with an elevation of 7,400 feet;

thence westerly approximately 2.3 miles along elevation 7,400 feet to a point on a spur ridge;

thence N. 55° W. approximately 3,600 feet to a point on the line between Sections 8 and 9, T. 9 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence northerly approximately 1.6 miles along the east boundaries of Sections 8 and 5 to the corner of Sections 4 and 5, T. 9 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence WEST, 1,000 feet along the north boundary of Section 5, T. 9 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence northerly approximately 3,800 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,258 feet;

thence northerly approximately 6,500 feet to a minor peak with an elevation of 7,148 feet;

thence northerly approximately 4,800 feet to a drainage at elevation 6,990 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 3,300 feet to a point on a ridge with an elevation of 7,193 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,500 feet to a drainage at an elevation of 7,200 feet;

thence northerly approximately 1.3 miles along elevation 7,200 feet to a point on a ridge;

thence northwesterly approximately 4,500 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,405 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,000 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,499 feet;

thence northerly approximately 3,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,500 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 6,000 feet to the west 1/4 corner of Section 29, T. 11 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence northerly approximately 1.5 miles along the west boundaries of Sections 29 and 20 to the corner for Sections 17 and 20;

thence northeasterly approximately 3,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 7,261 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,400 feet to the south 1/4 corner of Section 8, T. 11 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence northerly approximately 1 mile to the north 1/4 corner of said Section 8;

thence easterly approximately 1.3 miles along the north boundary of Sections 8 and 9 to a point with an elevation of 7,200 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 1.1 miles along elevation 7,200 feet to a point in the SOUTH FORK MOSQUITO CREEK;

thence northeasterly approximately 1,700 feet to a point 100 feet southeasterly from the end of USFS Road no. 44096 in MOSQUITO CREEK;

thence northerly approximately 2,900 feet to a point in a draw with an elevation of 7,200 feet;

thence northerly approximately 2.9 miles along elevation 7,200 feet to a point in a drainage;

thence approximately N. 40° W., 800 feet to a point on a ridge with an elevation of 7,400 feet;

thence northerly approximately 1.3 miles along elevation 7,400 feet to a draw near the protracted south boundary of Section 23, T. 12 N., R. 47 E., MDB&M;

thence EAST approximately 5,000 feet to a drainage with an approximate elevation of 7,840 feet;

thence EAST approximately 4,000 feet to a ridge with an approximate elevation of 8,400 feet;

thence EAST approximately 5,000 feet to a drainage with an approximate elevation of 7,840 feet;

thence EAST approximately 5,800 feet to a unnamed tributary of MORGAN CREEK with an approximate elevation of 8,240 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 4,300 feet to a peak with an elevation of 9,302 feet;

thence approximately N. 40° W., 5,100 feet to a point in a drainage at an elevation of 7,880 feet;

thence approximately N. 40° W., 3,600 feet to a point on a ridge at an elevation of 8,200 feet;

thence northerly approximately 3,300 feet to a point in a drainage at an elevation of 7,600 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 1,500 feet to a knob with an elevation of 7,800 feet;

thence easterly approximately 7,000 feet to a point in the bottom of WADSWORTH CREEK at an elevation of 7,720 feet;

thence easterly approximately 3,800 feet to Trail no. 39 on a ridge at an elevation of 8,165 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 4,100 feet to the trail from BLACK ROCK CANYON on a ridge at an elevation of 8,240 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 900 feet to a point in a drainage with an elevation of 8,040 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 3,200 feet descending drainage to the confluence of said drainage and the main creek in BLACK ROCK CANYON;

thence northeasterly approximately 2,700 feet to a point in a drainage with an elevation of 7,880 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 5,000 feet to a drainage with an elevation of 8,280 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 2,300 feet to a draw with an elevation of 8,800 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 2,900 feet to a point on a saddle with an approximate elevation of 9,260 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 900 feet along the ridge to a peak with an elevation of 9,338 feet;

thence SOUTH approximately 200 feet to elevation 9,200 feet;

thence southerly approximately 2,300 feet along elevation 9,200 feet to a draw;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,100 feet to a ridge at an elevation of 9,600 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,600 feet along elevation 9,600 feet to a ridge;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,700 feet to a ridge top with an approximate elevation of 9,140 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 2,100 feet along a ridge to a saddle with an approximate elevation of 8,820 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 1,800 feet ascending a ridge to a peak with an approximate elevation of 9,220 feet;

thence southwesterly approximately 4,500 feet to a point on a peak with an elevation of 9,622 feet;

thence southerly approximately 2,800 feet to a drainage and Trail no. 24075 at an elevation of 8,800 feet;

thence southeasterly approximately 2,400 feet along elevation 8,800 feet to a drainage;

thence southeasterly ascending said drainage approximately 2000 feet to a saddle with an approximate elevation of 9,230 feet;

thence easterly approximately 5,400 feet along the administrative boundary between the Austin and Tonopah Ranger Districts to a peak with an approximate elevation of 10,400 feet;

thence southerly and southeasterly approximately 1.7 miles descending along the ridge to the corner for Section 31, T. 12 N., R. 49 E., and Section 6, T. 11 N., R. 49 E., - The Point of Beginning;

Qualifications:

The boundary narrative for Table Mountain Wilderness is based on the 7 1/2 minute Quadrangle Maps listed below. This legal description has been plotted on the USDA Forest Service Primary Base Series Maps which are reduced to 1-inch-equals-1- mile. These maps are attached and made part of the description.

All references to Latitude and Longitude in this description are based on the North American Datum of 1927. All references to elevation in this description are based on the National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929.
