## Allegheny Islands Wilderness

Those islands, generally known as Crulls Island, Thompsons Island, Robert Thompsons Island, Courson Island, King Island, Baker Island and Dawson (No Name) Island, in the Allegheny River, within the Administrative Boundary of the Allegheny National Forest in Warren and Forest Counties, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and more particularly described as follows:

Crulls Island is located about one (1) mile downstream from the mouth of Brokenstraw Creek. Designated as U.S. Tract 992a containing 96.2 acres, be the same, more or less;

Thompsons Island is located about three and one-quarter (3-1/4) miles downstream from the highway bridge that carries Route 62 over the river at Irvine, Pennsylvania. Designated as U.S. Tract 965 containing 66.9 acres, be the same, more or less;

Robert Thompsons Island is located about six (6) miles downstream from the mouth of Brokenstraw Creek and immediately upstream from the mouth of Thompson Run. Designated as U.S. Tract 992Ah containing 31.8 acres, be the same, more or less;

Courson Island is located about one and one-half (1-1/2) miles above the bridge at Tidioute, Pennsylvania. Designated as U.S. Tracts 984 and 970 with a combined acreage of 61.5 acres, be the same, more or less;

King Island is located about one and one-half (1-1/2) miles downstream from the bridge over the river known as the "West Hickory" bridge. Designated as U.S. Tract 968 containing 35.7 acres, be the same, more or less;

Baker Island is located about three and one-half (3-1/2) miles upstream from the Borough of Tionesta. Designated as U.S. Tracts 992Af, 760f and U.S. Tract 993 with a combined acreage of 66.8 acres, be the same, more or less.

Dawson Island is located about one and one-half (1-1/2) miles upstream from the Borough of Tionesta immediately downstream from the Ruth E. Baker Island, U.S. Tract 993. Designated Tract 1012a containing 9.9 acres, be the same, more or less.

Lands herein described and topographic features referred to are depicted on 7-1/2 minute United States Geological Quadrangle sheets YOUNGSVILLE 1969 photo revised 1981, TIDIOUTE 1966 photo revised 1973, WEST HICKORY 1966 photo revised 1981.

Quadrangle sheets and U.S. Tracts referred to are intended to be an integral part of the legal description. The combined total area of the Allegheny Island Wilderness is 370 acres, be the same, more or less.
