

LITTLE LAKE CREEK WILDERNESS BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The Little Lake Creek Wilderness is located on the Sam Houston National Forest in Montgomery County, Texas. Bounded generally on the north by Forest Development Road (FDR) #211, on the east by (FDR) #231 and Texas Farm to Market Road #149, on the south by the National Forest Boundary and private land, on the west by an abandoned pipeline.

The Wilderness Boundary is delineated on the U.S.G.S. 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2 minute topographic quadrangles Montgomery, Richards and San Jacinto (modified for U.S.D.A. Forest Service use). Where actual field survey bearings and distances were not available, courses were digitized from the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, using the above named quads, and therefore should be considered approximate. Survey bearings are based on True North and digitized bearings are based on Grid North.

THE POINT OF BEGINNING and POINT #1, a point which is corner 87 of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV within the Willam Pattison Survey, Abstract No. 421 on the South Purchase Unit Boundary of the Sam Houston National Forest, an iron pipe with an aluminum cap set for corner.

Thence SOUTH, 1,181 feet along the boundary of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV, which is also the National Forest Boundary to Point #2, a point which is corner 88 of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV;

Thence S89° 00'W, 1,643 feet (digitized) along the boundary of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV, which is also the National Forest Boundary to Point #3, a point which is at the intersection of said tract and Forest Boundary with the northeasterly right-of-way line of an abandoned pipeline and about 200 feet east of the terminus of FDR #224;

Thence in a northwesterly direction, 23,028 feet (digitized) along the northeasterly right-of-way line of the abandoned pipeline to Point #4, a point on the northeasterly right-of-way line at the intersection with a line meandering northerly;

Thence leaving the right-of-way line of the abandoned pipeline and following in a northerly direction along the meanders of a line with the (35) courses (digitized):

to Point #5, a point which is at the intersection of the meander line and a line 100 feet south of and parallel to the centerline of (FDR) #211;

Thence in an easterly direction 2,128 feet (digitized), along a line that is 100 feet south of and parallel to the centerline of FDR #211 to Point #6, a point which is 100 feet southeasterly of the centerline of FDR #211 and 100 feet southeasterly of the centerline FDR #231;

Thence in a southeasterly direction, 25,407 feet (digitized), along a line that is 100 feet southwesterly of and parallel to the centerline of FDR #231 to Point #7, a point which is 100 feet southerly of the centerline of FDR #231 and on the west right-of-way line of Texas Farm to Market Road #149;

Thence in a southerly direction, 9,930 feet (digitized), along the west right-of-way line of Texas Farm to Market Road #149 to Point #8, a point at the intersection of said right-of-way and a fence line;

Thence leaving the west right-of-way line of Texas Farm to Market Road #149, and following the fence line S89° 00'W, approximately 594 feet to Point #9, a point on said fence line;

Thence leaving said fence line along a line S01° 00'E, approximately 149 feet to Point #10, a point which is on the boundary of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV between corners 86 and 87, which is also the National Forest Boundary;

Thence along the boundary of U.S.A. Tract #J-1-IV (National Forest Boundary) S89° 00'W, 3,286 feet (digitized) to THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

The Little Lake Creek Wilderness containing in aggregate 3,702 Acres more or less, as digitized from the above named quadrangle maps.
