

TURKEY HILL WILDERNESS ADDITION
BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The Turkey Hill Wilderness Addition is located on the Angelina National Forest, Angelina Ranger District, San Augustine County, Texas. Being bounded generally on the north and east by the Original Wilderness Boundary, on the south by Forest Development Road (FDR) #307, on the west by (FDR) #300 and Texas State Highway #147.

The Wilderness Boundary Addition is delineated on U.S.G.S. 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2 topographic quadrangle Harvey Creek (modified for USDA Forest Service use). Where actual field survey bearings and distances were not available, courses were digitized from the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, Central Zone, using the above named quad and therefore should be considered approximate. Survey bearings are based on True North and digitized bearings are based on Grid North.

THE POINT OF BEGINNING and Point #1, which is Point #6 of Original Wilderness Boundary and is a point 100 feet north of the centerline of (FDR) #307;

Thence S08°29'W, 67 feet (digitized) to Point #2, a point which is 33 feet north of the centerline of (FDR) #307;

Thence in a westerly and southwesterly direction along a line 33 feet north of and parallel to the centerline of (FDR) #307, approximately 11,948 feet (digitized) to Point #3, a point which is 33 feet easterly of the centerline of (FDR) #300;

Thence in a northwesterly direction along a line 33 feet easterly of and parallel to the centerline of (FDR) #300, approximately 10,542 feet (digitized) to Point #4, a point 50 feet southeasterly of the centerline and on the southeasterly right-of-way line of Texas State Highway #147;

Thence in a northeasterly direction along the southeasterly right-of-way line of said highway, approximately 2,932 feet (digitized) to Point #5, a point which intersects the north line of USA Tract #A-2i-I between corners 1 and 2 of said tract;

Thence along north boundary of USA Tract #A-2i-I N89°50E, 58 feet (digitized) to Point #6, a point is Point #9 on Original Wilderness Boundary and is 100 feet east of the centerline of Texas State Highway #147;

Thence in a southwesterly direction along Original Wilderness Boundary which is a line 100 feet southeasterly of and parallel to the centerline of said State Highway #147, approximately 2,914 feet (digitized) to Point #7, which is Point #8 of Original Wilderness Boundary and a point 100 feet easterly of (FDR) #300;

Thence in a southeasterly direction along Original Wilderness Boundary which is a line 100 feet northeasterly of and parallel to the centerline of (FDR) #300, approximately 10,462 feet (digitized) to Point #8, which is Point #7 of Original Wilderness Boundary and a point 100 feet north of the centerline of (FDR) #307;

Thence in a northeasterly and easterly direction along Original Wilderness Boundary which is a line 100 feet north of the centerline of (FDR) #307, to Point #1 and THE POINT OF BEGINNING.


The Turkey Hill Wilderness Addition containing in aggregate 38 Acres more or less as digitized from the above named quadrangle map.
