thence North 89°53' East a distance of 1137.8 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING
being at approximate 41°" North Latitude and 111°" West Longitude and elevation 9,000 feet;

thence ascending a spur Northerly for a distance of 725 feet more or less to approximate 41°" North Latitude and 111°" West Longitude and elevation 9,208 feet;

The Wilderness consists of an area of 31 acres added and 31 acres subtracted, more or less, which was computed from 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2' quadrangle maps using the Forest's Geographical Information System (GIS). A detailed description of the boundary follows.

MOUNT NAOMI WILDERNESS SUBTRACTION NO. 2 LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Beginning at the C-N-S-S 1/256 corner of section 25, T. 12 N., R. 1 E., SLM on the existing Westerly boundary of the Mount Naomi Wilderness created by PL 98-428 (1984) and amended by PL 105-355 (1998) and PL 108-95 (2003) and running thence Northerly along the North-South centerline of said section 25 a distance of 980 feet more or less;

thence along said wilderness boundary approximately North 18°48' East a distance of 1,380 feet more or less to the line common to sections 24 and 25, said Township and Range;

thence running along said line and wilderness boundary approximately East a distance of 300 feet more or less to the W-W-E 1/256 corner common to said sections 24 and 25;

thence continuing approximately East along the line common to said sections 24 and 25 a distance of 48 feet more or less;

thence approximately South 35 chains;

thence approximately West 48 feet more or less to the C-S-SW-NE 1/256 corner of said section 25;

thence Westerly a distance of 5 chains more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

ADDITION NO. 2 LEGAL DESCRIPTION (PL 108-95, 2003)

Beginning at a point on the existing Mount Naomi Wilderness boundary in Section 34, T. 13 N., R. 2 E., Salt Lake Meridian at approximate Latitude 41°49'41.64" North and Longitude 111°42'40.49" West;

thence along said wilderness boundary Southeasterly for a distance of 2,175 feet more or less to a point at approximate Latitude 41°49'22.74" North and Longitude 111°42'26.81" West;

thence continuing along said existing wilderness boundary Southwesterly to a point at approximate Latitude 41°49'13.12" North and Longitude 111°42'40.15" West;

thence Northerly a distance of 2,890 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Contains 31 acres more or less.

OVERALL ADJUSTED LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The area included in the Mount Naomi Wilderness is located on the Cache National Forest, Intermountain Region, Rich County, Utah, according to the "Utah Wilderness Act of 1984." The official boundary description and maps on which the boundary is shown are on file and available in the offices of the Forest Supervisor, Wasatch-Cache National Forest, Salt Lake City, Utah, and the Regional Forester, Intermountain Region, Ogden, Utah. The Wilderness consists of an area of 44,617 acres, more or less, which was computed from 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2' quadrangle maps using the Forest's Geographical Information System (GIS). A detailed description of the boundary follows:

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION:

Beginning at a point on the North South centerline of Section 25, Township 12 North, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Meridian, Cache County, Utah on a ridge which is approximately North 1,000 feet from the 1/4 corner of sections 25 and 36, said Township and Range, said point being at approximate 41°44'48.48" North Latitude and 111°47'05.46" West Longitude;

thence approximately North along said North South centerline, a distance of 1,947.1 feet more or less to the C-N-S-S 1/256 corner of said section;

thence East 5 chains more or less to the C-S-SW-NE 1/256 corner of said section 25;

thence continuing East 48 feet more or less;

thence approximately North 35 chains to the line common to sections 24 and 25, said Township and Range;

thence approximately East a distance of 1,923.8 feet along the North line of said Section 25 to the Southwest corner of sections 19 & 30, T. 12 N., R. 2 E., SLM and sections 25 & 36, T. 12 N., R. 1 E., SLM;

thence approximately North a distance of 3,200 feet more or less along the West line of said Section 19 to a 300 foot Southerly offset of the centerline of the road in GREEN CANYON at approximate 41°45'58.88" North Latitude and 111°46'31.46" West Longitude;

thence Northeasterly along said Southerly offset a distance of 5.5 miles more or less to the bottom of a draw at approximate elevation 6,800 feet in the NE1/4SE1/4 of Section 3, T12N R2E, said point being at approximate 41°48'38.38" North Latitude and 111°41'59.87" West Longitude;

thence approximately North 73° West a distance of 2,560 feet more or less to the top of a knob at elevation 7,670 feet at approximate 41°48'46.54" North Latitude and 111°42'31.83" West Longitude;

thence Northwesterly and Northeasterly along a ridge line a distance of 2,825 feet more or less to elevation 8,040 feet at approximate 41°49'13.12" North Latitude and 111°42'40.15" West Longitude;

thence Northerly a distance of 2,890 feet more or less to approximate 41°49'41.64" North Latitude and 111°42'40.49" West Longitude

thence approximately North 30°30' West a distance of 400 feet more or less to the bottom of WATER CANYON at elevation 7,960 feet;

thence approximately North 48° West a distance of 2,200 feet more or less to the top of a knob between WATER CANYON and DRY CANYON at approximate 41°49'59.68" North Latitude and 111°43'06.02" West Longitude and elevation 8,930 feet;

thence Southwesterly along a ridge between said canyons a distance of 780 feet more or less to 41°49'54.49" North Latitude and 111°43'14.00" West Longitude and elevation 9,000 feet;

thence Southwesterly along elevation 9,000 feet a distance of 1,625 feet more or less to a ridge at approximate 41°49'42.29" North Latitude and 111°43'27.94" West Longitude

thence Southwesterly approximately 5.2 miles along the main ridge line Northwest of GREEN CANYON to the National Forest Boundary on the North line of section 19, T. 12 N., R. 2 E., SLM, at a point approximately 530 feet East of the Northwest corner of said section at approximate 41°46'21.76" North Latitude and 111°46'24.79" West Longitude;

thence approximately West a distance of 530 feet more or less to the section corner of sections 18 & 19, T. 12 N., R. 2 E., SLM and sections 13 & 24, T. 12 N., R. 1 E., SLM

thence generally Northerly approximately 6.4 miles along the National Forest boundary to a point on the West line of section 19, T. 13 N., R. 2 E., SLM at a 100 foot Southerly offset of the centerline of the road and trail in BIRCH CANYON at approximate 41°51'08.69" North Latitude and 111°46'35.62" West Longitude;

thence Easterly along said Southerly offset a distance of 2.1 miles more or less to a point near the East line of section 20, T. 13 N., R. 2 E., SLM at approximately 41°51'28.49" North Latitude and 111°44'20.81" West Longitude;

thence Northeasterly approximately 200 feet, crossing BIRCH CANYON, to a 100 foot Northerly offset of the trail in BIRCH CANYON;

thence Westerly along said Northerly offset a distance of 2.1 miles more or less to the West line of said Section 19 and the National Forest Boundary;

thence generally Northerly a distance of 2.1 miles more or less along the National Forest Boundary to a point on the West line of section 17, T. 13 N., R. 2 E., SLM at a 100 foot Southerly offset of the centerline of the road in SMITHFIELD CANYON;

thence Northeasterly along said Southerly offset a distance of 3.2 miles more or less to a 100 foot Easterly offset of a point on said centerline near THE GROTTTO, said centerline point being at approximately 41°53'34.58" North Latitude and 111°42'10.73" West Longitude;

thence approximately West a distance of 200 feet more or less to a 100 foot Westerly offset of the centerline of the road/trail in said canyon;

thence Southwesterly along said Westerly offset a distance of 3.2 miles more or less to the West line of section 17, T. 13 N., R. 2 E., SLM at a point 100 feet North of said road at approximate 41°52'11.05" North Latitude and 111°45'28.41" West Longitude;

thence generally Northerly a distance of 9.8 miles more or less along the boundary between private and National Forest System lands to the 1/4 section corner of sections 5 & 8, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM at approximate 41°58'35.02" North Latitude and 111°44'57.75" West Longitude;

thence Westerly along the section line of sections 5 and 8, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM a distance of 1,887 feet more or less to a 100 foot Southeasterly offset of Forest Service road No. 20048;

thence Easterly along said Southeasterly road offset a distance of 5,925 feet more less to the section line common to sections 4 and 9, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM at a point which bears approximately South 89°38' East a distance of 1,104.0 feet more or less from the Southwest corner of said section 4;

thence approximately South 24°37' West a distance of 245 feet more or less;

thence approximately South 65°23' East a distance of 844 feet more or less;

thence approximately North 24°37' East a distance of 330 feet more or less to a 100 foot Southwesterly offset of Forest Service road No. 20048 at approximate 41°58'32.43" North Latitude and 111°43'58.41" West Longitude;

thence Easterly along said offset a distance of 7,000 feet more or less to a 100 foot Southerly offset of the endpoint of said road, said endpoint being at approximate Latitude 41°58'27.91" North and Longitude 111°42'32.82" West;

thence counterclockwise along a 100 foot radius curve through an angle of 180 degrees more or less to the Northerly offset of said Forest Service road No. 20048;

thence Westerly along said Northerly offset a distance of 2.7 miles more or less to the South line of section 5, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM;

thence approximately North 89°54' West a distance of 472.6 feet more or less to the section corner of sections 5, 6, 7, & 8, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM;

thence North 0°01' West 20 chains more or less to the South 1/16 corner common to sections 5 & 6, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM;

thence North 89°51' East a distance of 2609.4 feet more or less to the C-S 1/16 section corner of section 5, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM;

thence approximately North 89°51' East 2609.4 feet more or less to the South 1/16 corner common to sections 4 and 5, said Township and Range;

thence approximately North 0°02' East a distance of 3,956.0 feet more or less to the corner of sections 4 & 5, T. 14 N., R. 2 E., SLM and section 32 & 33, T. 15 N., R. 2 E., SLM;

thence North 1°22' East a distance of 3075.2 feet more or less to the corner of sections 32 & 33 only on the UTAH AND IDAHO STATE LINE;

thence along said state line approximately South 89°54' East a distance of 3,072 feet more or less to a ridge at elevation 6,800 feet more or less at approximate 41°59'57.70" North Latitude and 111°43'42.48" West Longitude and elevation 6,800 feet;

thence Easterly and Southeasterly approximately 1.8 miles along a ridge line to the top of a peak at approximate 41°59'46.00" North Latitude and 111°42'13.72" West Longitude and elevation 8,303 feet;

thence continuing along said ridge for a distance of 2,700 feet more or less to a peak at 41°59'48.14" North Latitude and 111°41'42.16" West Longitude and elevation 8,470 feet more or less;

thence approximately South 82° East a distance of 1.8 miles passing through a peak at approximate 41°59'47.78" North Latitude and 111°41'05.45" West Longitude to a peak at approximate 41°59'35.29" North Latitude and 111°39'39.85" West Longitude and elevation 9,454 feet;

thence Southerly approximately 7.6 miles along the main ridge line of the BEAR RIVER RANGE divide to the top of a peak at approximate 41°53'51.18" North Latitude and 111°40'07.69" West Longitude and elevation 9,676 feet;

thence Southeasterly approximately 5.5 miles along the main ridge line Easterly above COTTONWOOD CANYON to the top of a knob at approximate 41°49'50.25" North Latitude and 111°38'03.74" West Longitude and elevation 7,481 feet;

thence approximately South 76° West a distance of 4,600 feet more or less, crossing COTTONWOOD CANYON, to the top of a knob at approximate 41°49'39.48" North Latitude and 111°39'02.81" West Longitude and elevation 7,214 feet;

thence Westerly along a ridge line a distance of 1.4 miles more or less to a peak at approximate 41°49'41.56" North Latitude and 111°40'33.40" West Longitude and elevation 8,659 feet;

thence approximately South 52°12' West a distance of 1851.7 feet more or less to a peak at approximate 41°49'30.38" North Latitude and 111°40'52.61" West Longitude and elevation 9,065 feet more or less;

thence Southwesterly along the main ridge line between LOGAN CANYON and GREEN CANYON a distance of 7.3 miles more or less to a point 100 feet Northeasterly from a communications site, said site being centered at approximately 41°45'24.51" North Latitude and 111°45'48.61" West Longitude;

thence Southwesterly approximately 200 feet, maintaining a 100 foot distance from said communication site, returning to said ridge line;

thence Southwesterly along said ridge line a distance of 1.5 miles more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
