


NATIONAL WILDERNESS PRESERVATION SYSTEM

MOUNT TIMPANOGOS WILDERNESS  
LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The area included in the Mount Timpanogos Wilderness is located on the Uinta National Forest, Intermountain Region, Utah County, Utah, according to the "Utah Wilderness Act of 1984." The official boundary description and maps on which the boundary is shown are on file and available in the offices of the Forest Supervisor, Uinta National Forest, Provo, Utah, and the Regional Forester, Intermountain Region, Ogden, Utah. The Wilderness consists of an area of 10,518 acres, more or less, and was computed from 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2' quadrangle maps using the Forest's Geographical Information System (GIS). A detailed description of the boundary follows.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 29, Township 5 South, Range 3 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, Utah County, Utah;

thence approximately N 34° W 1,200 feet to the bottom of drainage at elevation 6,880 feet;

thence approximately N38° W 2450 feet to the bottom of a drainage at approximate elevation 7106 feet;

thence approximately N 50° W, 3,000 feet to the top of a ridge on the north line of Section 30, said ridge is east approximately 500 feet from the northwest corner of said section;

thence northerly approximately 3,400 feet to the low point of a saddle at elevation 8,332 feet which is approximately 100 feet west of a trail in the NW1/4 of Section 19;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,100 feet to the northwest corner of Section 19;

thence northwesterly approximately 1,800 feet to the bottom of BATTLE CREEK at elevation 8,600 feet;

thence northwesterly approximately 2,000 feet to the bottom of NORTH FORK BATTLE CREEK at elevation 8,800 feet;

thence approximately N 26° W, 1.5 miles to the bottom of a drainage on the north line of Section 12 at approximate elevation 9,160 feet;

thence N 41° W approximately 1.3 miles to a point 100 feet southeasterly from a trail near the north line of Section 2 at approximate elevation 8,760 feet;

thence northeasterly approximately 4,400 feet, 100 feet southeasterly from and parallel with said trail, to elevation 8,400 feet near the ridge dividing BURNED CANYON and ROCK CANYON ;

thence easterly approximately 500 feet along elevation 8,400 feet to a point 100 feet southerly from a trail;

thence easterly approximately 3,500 feet, 100 feet southerly from and parallel with said trail or road, whichever is southern most, to a point at approximate elevation 8280 feet said point bears approximately S 59°W 3,000 feet from the NW corner of section 31, T4S R3E;

thence approximately S 65° E, 1,500 feet to the bottom of a drainage at approximate elevation 9,000 feet;

thence easterly descending said drainage approximately 3,100 feet to approximate elevation 7640 feet, near a spring;

thence S 86° E approximately 2,800 feet to the west line of section 32, T4S R3E;

thence approximately N 50° E, 2,100 feet to a point which is 200 feet south from the centerline of the ALPINE SCENIC LOOP HWY. from it's southern-most point in the NW 1/4 of Section 32;

thence approximately S 43° E, 3,100 feet to the top of a ridge line at elevation 8,720 feet;

thence southerly ascending said ridge approximately 5,200 feet to the top of a peak at elevation 10,233 feet;

thence southeasterly and northeasterly descending a ridge line approximately 3,000 feet to elevation 8,940 feet;

thence southeasterly descending a ridge line approximately 1,700 feet to elevation 8,600 feet;

thence approximately S 31° E, 2,200 feet to the N 1/4 corner of Section 9, T5S R3E;

thence approximately S 36° E, 500 feet to the MOUNT TIMPANOGOS TRAIL;

thence approximately S 9° E, 2,000 feet to a ridge at elevation 8,000 feet;

thence southwesterly to the SE corner of Section 9 T5S R3E;

thence south along the east lines of Sections 16, 21 and 28 approximately 3.0 miles to the SE corner of Section 28;

thence west along the south lines of Sections 28 and 29 approximately 2.0 miles to the SW corner of Section 29, the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Qualifications:

All information was taken from 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2' Primary Base Series quadrangle maps which were mapped, edited, and published by the U.S. Geological Survey, and modified by the Forest Service Geometrics Service Center using 1985 photography and 1985 correction guides furnished by the Intermountain Region.

This boundary description has been plotted on a set of U.S. Geological Survey 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2' quadrangle maps which are reduced to a 1-inch-equals-1-mile map entitled "Mount Timpanogos Wilderness", Uinta National Forest, Intermountain Region, dated April 4, 1988, which is attached and made part of this description.
