



## JAMES RIVER FACE ADDITION A

### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The James River Face Wilderness Addition A is on the Jefferson National Forest in Rockbridge and Bedford Counties, Virginia.

All distance and bearings were determined from the Virginia State Plane Coordinate System form U.S.G.S., 1/24,000, 7 1/2' topographic quad Snowden, (modified for USDA Forest Service use). Bearings are referenced from grid North and expressed in degrees and minutes.

All distances are map distances that were digitized from the preceding named quad, and therefore should be considered as approximate.

Beginning at a point of the original James River Face Wilderness Description, a 3-inch brass capped concrete post marked U.S.D.I. - 1,130, is common to both USDA Forest Service, Tract N 50, and the National Park Service.

Thence along the common boundary of the Jefferson National Forest and the National Park Service the following four courses:

# JAMES RIVER FACE ADDITION B

## BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The James River Face Wilderness Addition B is on the Jefferson National Forest in Bedford County.

All distances and bearings were determined from the Virginia State Plane coordinate System from U.S.G.S., 1/24,000, 7 1/2 topographic quad, Snowden (modified for USDA Forest Service use). Bearings are referenced from grid north and expressed in degrees and minutes.

All distances are map distances that were digitized from the proceeding named quad, and therefore should be considered as approximate.

Beginning at a point N 63° 22' W, 545 Feet from the intersection of the Snow Creek Road and U.S. 501. This being a point after the following course N 17.9° W, 0.025, mile as described in the original James River Face Description on Page JRF2.

Thence from said P.O.B.:

of the centerline of the woods road  
(formerly the entrance road to the  
old Snow Creek Recreation Area);

of and parallel to the centerline of said woods road:
