## MOUNTAIN LAKE WILDERNESS ADDITION

### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Mountain Lake Wilderness Addition is located on the Jefferson National Forest in Monroe County, West Virginia.

The wilderness boundary is delineated on the U.S.G.S. 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2 minute Topographic Quagrange Waiteville (Modified for USDA Forest Service Use). All bearings and distances were digitized from the Virginia State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone and the West Virginia State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone from the above named quad and therefore should be considered approximate. Bearings are referenced from Grid North and expressed in degrees and minutes. All distances are map distances that are expressed in Feet which were digitized from the above named quad.

The Wilderness Boundary is more particularly described as follows:

THE POINT OF BEGINNING and Point #1, a point S 00° 57' E, 1,074 Feet from Bench Mark 2662. This point being 100 Feet south of the centerline of an old railroad bed;
