BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

GOAT ROCKS WILDERNESS

The Goat Rocks Wilderness consists of an area in the State of Washington, referenced to the Willamette Meridian, centered in unsurveyed T. 12 N., R. 11 E., and more properly described as:

Beginning at a point located in an unsurveyed portion of T. 12 N., R. 11 E., said point being a peak on the crest of the Cascade Range which is common to the boundaries of Lewis and Yakima Counties, Gifford Pinchot and Snoqualmie National Forests, and Yakima Indian Reservation, and is located 4.42 miles, S. $57^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Bear Creek Mountain (abandoned) Lookout, 3.92 miles, S. 59° E. of Hawkeye Point Lookout, and 4.48 miles, N. 79° E. of Goat Ridge Lookout;

Thence southerly along the crest of the Cascade Range, which is the Yakima Indian Reservation boundary, 9.25 miles to Lakeview Mountain (abandoned) Lookout;

Thence westerly along the crest of the Cascade Range, which is the Yakima Indian Reservation boundary, 3.6 miles to a point 1.24 miles south of the south shore of Walupt Lake, 3.07 miles, N. 82° W. of Lakeview Mountain (abandoned) Lookout, and 3.0 miles, S. 19° W. of triangulation station Nannie;

Thence northerly 1.6 miles to a point in Walupt Lake which is 3.63 miles, N. 57° W. of Lakeview Mountain (abandoned) Lookout and 1.52 miles, S. $38^{\circ} 30'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie;

Thence easterly 0.5 mile to a point in Walupt Lake which is 3.22 miles, N. 51° W. of Lakeview Mountain (abandoned) Lookout, 1.28 miles, S. $20^{\circ} 15'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie, and 0.86 mile, S. $64^{\circ} 45'$ E. of the outlet of Walupt Lake;

Thence northerly 1.0 mile to a point 3.93 miles, N. $40^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Lakeview Mountain (abandoned) Lookout, 0.5 mile, S. $66^{\circ} 30'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie, and 1.96 miles, S. 76° E. of the junction of Nannie Creek and the Cispus River;

Thence westerly 2.4 miles to a point west of the Cispus River which is 0.65 mile, S. $50^{\circ} 15'$ W. of the junction of Nannie Creek and the Cispus River, 3.4 miles, S. 5° E. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 1.78 miles, N. $67^{\circ} 30'$ W. of the outlet of Walupt Lake;

Thence northerly 3.13 miles to a point which is 0.4 mile, S. 51° E. of Goat Ridge Lookout, 4.12 miles, N. 44° W. of triangulation station Nannie, and 2.75 miles, N. 10° W. of the junction of Nannie Creek and Cispus River;

Thence westerly 0.75 mile to a point 0.48 mile, S. 60° W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, 4.64 miles, N. $50^{\circ} 30'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie, and 3.43 miles, S. $25^{\circ} 45'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence northerly 0.2 mile to a point which is 0.45 mile, S. $82^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, 3.27 miles, S. $27^{\circ} 45'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout and 4.8 miles, N. $48^{\circ} 45'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie;

Thence westerly 0.72 mile to a point which is 5.37 miles, N. $54^{\circ} 15'$ W. of triangulation station Nannie, 3.65 miles, S. $37^{\circ} 45'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout, and 1.18 miles, S. $87^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout;

Thence north 1.0 mile to a point south of Jordan Creek which is 1.52 miles, N. 52° W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 2.93 miles, S. $49^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence west 0.5 mile to the center of Jordan Creek flowing southwesterly, said point being 1.95 miles, N. $61^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 3.35 miles, S. $55^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence north 0.97 mile to a point south of Middle Fork which is 2.55 miles, N. $41^{\circ} 45'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 2.88 miles, S. $71^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence westerly 1.0 mile to a point south of the Middle Fork which is 3.5 miles, N. $54^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, 3.83 miles, S. $76^{\circ} 45'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout, and 2.4 miles, S. $61^{\circ} 15'$ E. of the junction of Deception Creek and Johnson Creek;

Thence north 1.0 mile to a point which is 3.96 miles, N. $41^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 3.72 miles, N. $89^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence west 1.0 mile to a point which is 4.68 miles, N. $51^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Goat Ridge Lookout, and 4.72 miles, N. $89^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence north 3.02 miles to a point which is 5.66 miles, N. 57° W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout, and 0.98 mile, N. $89^{\circ} 30'$ E. of southeast corner of Sec. 36, T. 13 N., R. 9 E.;

Thence east 2.5 miles to a point south of Upper Lake Creek, which is 3.82 miles, N. 36° W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout, and 3.5 miles, S. 27° W. of Lost Lake Lookout;

Thence northerly 1.98 miles to a point which is 3.48 miles, east of the northeast corner of Sec. 25, T. 13 N., R. 9 E., 1.98 miles, S. $54^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Lost Lake Lookout, and 5.55 miles, N. $24^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Hawkeye Point Lookout;

Thence westerly 0.5 mile to a point which is 2.99 miles east of the northeast corner of Sec. 25, T. 13 N., R. 9 E., 2.38 miles, S. $61^{\circ} 0'$ W. of Lost Lake Lookout, and 4.03 miles, S. $00^{\circ} 45'$ E. of the southwest corner of Sec. 34, T. 14 N., R. 10 E.;

Thence northerly 4.03 miles to the southwest corner of Sec. 34;

Thence east 3.0 miles along the south lines of Secs. 34, 35, and 36, to the southeast corner of Sec. 36;

Thence east 0.54 mile to a point 3.2 miles, N. $25^{\circ} 30'$ E. of Lost Lake Lookout, and 5.05 miles, N. $43^{\circ} 0'$ W. of triangulation station Hogback Mountain;

Thence south 0.61 mile to a point 2.66 miles, N. $31^{\circ} 15'$ E. of Lost Lake Lookout, and 0.84 mile, S. $42^{\circ} 30'$ E. of the southeast corner of Sec. 36, T. 14 N., R. 10 E.;

Thence easterly 0.52 mile to a point 0.1 mile west of Clear Fork Creek, 1.25 miles, S. $60^{\circ} 30'$ E. of southeast corner of Sec. 36, and 2.95 miles, N. $40^{\circ} 0'$ E. of Lost Lake Lookout;

Thence southerly 1.6 miles to a point which is 3.26 miles, N. $62^{\circ} 0'$ W. of triangulation station Hogback Mountain, 2.04 miles, N. $69^{\circ} 30'$ E. of Lost Lake Lookout, and 2.45 miles, S. $26^{\circ} 30'$ E. of southeast corner of Sec. 36, T. 14 N., R. 10 E.;

Thence easterly 3.73 miles to a point, on the crest of the Cascade Range located in unsurveyed portions of T. 13 N., R. 11 E., which is common to the boundaries of Lewis and Yakima counties and the Gifford Pinchot and Snoqualmie National Forests and which is 1.76 miles, N. $29^{\circ} 30'$ E. of triangulation station Hogback Mountain, 4.33 miles, N. $22^{\circ} 0'$ W. of northwest corner of Sec. 5, T. 12 N., R. 12 E., and 2.85 miles, S. $72^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Round Mountain Lookout;

Thence easterly 1.26 miles, to a point which is 0.76 mile west of Hell Creek, 1.67 miles, S. $61^{\circ} 0'$ W. of Round Mountain Lookout, and 2.64 miles, N. $53^{\circ} 45'$ E. of triangulation station Hogback Mountain;

Thence south 4.05 miles to a point in Tieton Meadows which is 0.12 mile east of the North Fork Tieton River, 5.03 miles, S. $16^{\circ} 25'$ W. of Round Mountain Lookout, and 0.33 mile west of northwest corner of Sec. 5, T. 12 N., R. 12 E.

Thence east 0.33 mile to the northwest corner of Sec. 5;

Thence southerly 2.2 miles along the west lines of Secs. 5 and 8 to the southwest corner of Sec. 8;

Thence easterly 0.5 mile along north line of Sec. 17, to the north quarter corner of Sec. 17;

Thence southerly 1.0 mile to the south quarter corner of Sec. 17;

Thence easterly 0.5 mile along south line of Sec. 17 to the southeast corner of Sec. 17;

Thence southerly 3.0 miles along west lines of Secs. 21, 28, and 33 to the southwest corner of Sec. 33;

Thence southerly 0.938 mile along the west line of Sec. 4, T. 11 N., R. 12 E., to the southwest corner of Sec. 4;

Thence southerly 0.005 mile along the west line of Sec. 9, to the Forest boundary on Klickton Divide;

Thence northwesterly approximately 5.61 miles along a ridge which is the boundary between the Yakima Indian Reservation and the Snoqualmie National Forest to the point of beginning, containing 82,680 acres more or less

The preceding description relates to General Land Office (Bureau of Land Management) record bearings and distances wherever official G.L.O. surveys have been made. In other areas the description relates to approximate bearings and distances as scaled from the accompanying 1 inch = 1 mile scale map reproduced from reduced portions of U. S. Forest Service 15' planimetric quadrangles revised to 1961.
