BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

MOUNT ADAMS WILDERNESS

The Mount Adams Wilderness consists of an area in the State of Washington, referenced to the Willamette Meridian, centered in unsurveyed T. 9 N., R. 11 E., and more properly described as:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Sec. 30, T. 8 N., R. 10 E., thence northerly 5.62 miles to a point which is 1.28 miles, N. $49^{\circ} 30'$ E., of the junction of Big Spring Creek and Riley Creek, 2.45 miles, S. $29^{\circ} 45'$ E. of triangulation station Council Bluff, and 0.63 mile, N. 10° W. of the junction of Riley Creek and Mutton Creek;

Thence easterly 1.0 mile to a point which is 0.16 mile south of the center of Big Spring Creek, 1.42 miles, N. $27^{\circ} 15'$ W., of the outlet of a small unnamed lake draining into Riley Creek, and 3.08 miles, S. $45^{\circ} 35'$ E. of triangulation station Council Bluff;

Thence northerly 0.96 mile to a point which is 2.5 miles, S. $62^{\circ} 30'$ E. of triangulation station Council Bluff, 1.86 miles, N. $29^{\circ} 15'$ E. of the junction of Riley Creek and Mutton Creek, and 2.36 miles, N. $16^{\circ} 15'$ W. of the outlet of an unnamed lake flowing into Riley Creek;

Thence easterly 3.05 miles to a point which is 3.28 miles, N. 47° E. of the outlet of an unnamed lake flowing into Riley Creek, 5.4 miles, S. 78° E. of triangulation station Council Bluff, and 4.32 miles, S. $38^{\circ} 15'$ E. of the junction of Adams Creek and Killen Creek;

Thence northerly 3.0 miles to a point which is 2.0 miles, S. $65^{\circ} 45'$ E. of the outlet of Horseshoe Lake, 2.67 miles, S. $80^{\circ} 45'$ E. of the junction of Killen Creek and Adams Creek, and 2.7 miles, S. $29^{\circ} 30'$ W. of Potato Hill;

Thence easterly 2.02 miles to a point which is 2.49 miles, S. $16^{\circ} 45'$ E. of Potato Hill, 3.84 miles, S. 78° E. of the outlet of Horseshoe Lake, and 2.83 miles, N. $62^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Glaciate Butte;

Thence northerly 0.25 mile to a point which is 2.22 miles, S. $18^{\circ} 30'$ E. of Potato Hill, 3.92 miles, S. 82° E. of the outlet of Horseshoe Lake, and 2.98 miles, N. 58° W. of Glaciate Butte;

Thence easterly 0.58 mile to a point on the crest of the Cascade Range which is common to the Gifford Pinchot National Forest and the Yakima Indian Reservation boundaries, and which is 2.48 miles, S. $30^{\circ} 30'$ E. of Potato Hill, 2.5 miles, N. $51^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Glaciate Butte, and 4.18 miles, S. $74^{\circ} 30'$ W. of triangulation station Clearwater;

Thence southerly along the crest of the Cascade Range, which is the Yakima Indian Reservation boundary, approximately 5.65 miles to a point which is 2.09 miles, N. $41^{\circ} 45'$ E. of Mt. Adams, elevation 12,326 feet, 2.18 miles, N. $56^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Goat Butte Lookout, and 3.9 miles, S. $19^{\circ} 15'$ W. of Glaciate Butte;

Thence S. $56^{\circ} 15'$ E., 2.18 miles along the Yakima Indian Reservation boundary to an angle point near Goat Butte Lookout;

Thence S. 48° E., 4.86 miles along the Yakima Indian Reservation boundary to a point on the south section line of Sec. 19, T. 8 N., R. 12 E., which bears N. $89^{\circ} 45'$ W., 0.34 mile from the southeast corner of Sec. 19;

Thence west along the south line of Sec. 19, 0.667 mile to the southwest corner of Sec. 19;

Thence north 0.019 mile to the northeast corner of Sec. 25;

Thence westerly 1.499 miles along the north lines of Secs. 25 and 26 to the north quarter corner of Sec. 26;

Thence north 0.5 mile to a point above Hellroaring Creek;

Thence westerly, parallel to the north lines of Secs. 26 and 27, 1.001 miles to a point 0.5 mile north of the north quarter corner of Sec. 27;

Thence south 0.5 mile to the north quarter corner of Sec. 27;

Thence westerly 3.412 miles along the north lines of Secs. 27, 28, 29, and 30 to the northwest corner of Sec. 30;

Thence south 0.144 mile to the northeast corner of Sec. 25, T. 8 N., R. 10 E.;

Thence westerly 6.0 miles along the north lines of Secs. 25 through 30 to the northwest corner of Sec. 30, the point of beginning, containing 42,411 acres more or less.

The preceding description relates to General Land Office (Bureau of Land Management) record bearings and distances wherever official G.L.O. surveys have been made. In other areas the description relates to approximate bearings and distances as scaled from the accompanying 1 inch = 1 mile scale map reproduced from reduced portions of U.S. Forest Service 15' planimetric quadrangles revised to 1961.
