TETON WILDERNESS

The Exterior Boundary of Teton Wilderness, Teton National Forest Intermountain Region, as reported to Congress pursuant to Section 3 (a) (1) of the Wilderness Act, (Public Law 88-577)

Description

Beginning at the southeast corner of Yellowstone National Park; thence north approximately 13.0 miles along the east boundary of said park to its intersection with the boundary of the Teton National Forest at a point approximately midway between Eagle Peak and Pinnacle Mountain; thence, following the divide between the Shoshone River and Yellowstone River drainages, easterly to Pinnacle Mountain; southeasterly across Chaos Mountain, Overlook Mountain, Ishawooa Cone, Ishawooa Pass, and Kingfisher Peak; southerly to Crescent Mountain; thence southwesterly following the divide between Wind River and Buffalo River drainages passing north of Upper Brooks Lakes; thence south to the divide between Blackrock Creek and the Buffalo River; thence northwesterly following this divide across Breccia Peak to a point 3.25 miles due east and 0.30 miles due south of the northeast section corner of Section 36, T. 45 N., R. 112 W.; thence north 0.90 miles; thence west 2.0 miles; thence north 0.50 miles; thence west 1.25 miles to the township line between R. 111 W. and R. 112 W., thence north 2.0 miles to the northeast corner of Section 13, T. 45 N., R. 112 W.; thence west 10.0 miles to the southwest corner of Section 9, T. 45 N., R. 113 W.; thence north 4.75 miles to Pacific Creek; thence west 0.50 miles; thence approximately 4,750.0 feet S. 34° W.; thence west approximately 0.50 mile to the northeast boundary corner of the Grand Teton National Park in Pacific Creek; thence west along this National Park boundary approximately 4.50 miles; thence north 1.0 mile; thence west 1.0 mile; thence northward following the divide west of Pilgrim Creek to Wildcat Peak; thence northward following the divide across Huckleberry Mountain to the south boundary of Yellowstone National Park; thence east along said park approximately 29.0 miles to the southeast corner of said park, the place of beginning, containing 563,500 acres more or less.

As shown on the 1 inch-equals-1-mile maps, sheets 1 through 5, designated "The Teton Wilderness" which are attached to and made a part of this description.
