WINEGAR HOLE WILDERNESS

The area included in the Winegar Hole Wilderness is located on the Targhee National Forest, Intermountain Region, Teton County, Wyoming, according to the "Wyoming Wilderness Act of 1984." The official boundary description and maps on which the boundary is shown are on file and available in the offices of the Forest Supervisor, Targhee National Forest, St. Anthony, Idaho, and the Regional Forester, Intermountain Region, Ogden, Utah. It consists of an area of 10,715 acres, more or less. A detailed description of the boundary follows:

Legal Description

Beginning at the point of intersection of the south bank of the Falls River and the Yellowstone National Park boundary in Section 10, T. 48 N., R. 118 W., 6th Principal Meridian, Wyoming;

Thence, east along said boundary to the northeast corner of Section 9, T. 48 N., R. 117 W.;

Thence, south along the east section lines of Section 9 and 16 to the ridge top between Calf Creek and the Reclamation Road;

Thence, westerly along said ridge top approximately 1.5 miles to the 7,000 foot elevation;

Thence, N. 80° W., approximately 0.4 of a mile to a ridge top at approximately the 7,000 foot elevation.

Thence, southwesterly along said ridge top approximately 0.35 of a mile to the east section line of Section 18;

Thence, north along the section line to the east one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) corner of Section 18;

Thence, west to the east one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) corner of Section 13, T. 48 N., R. 118 W.;

Thence, south along the east section lines of Sections 13 and 24 to the north bank of North Boone Creek;

Thence, southwesterly along the north bank of said creek to the east section line of Section 26;

Thence, south along said section line to the north bank of Middle Boone Creek;

Thence, southwesterly along the north bank of said creek to the east section line of Section 34;

Thence, south along said section line to the southeast corner of Section 34;

Thence, west along the south township line of T. 48 N., to the Idaho/Wyoming State boundary line;

Thence, north along said State boundary line to the south bank of the Falls River;

Thence, northeasterly along the south bank of said river to the Yellowstone National Park boundary and the point of beginning.

Qualifications

All information taken from 1:24,000 PBS quadrangle maps (National Geodetic Vertical Datum of 1929, polyconic projection - 1927 North American Datum) which were mapped, edited, and published by the U.S. Geological Survey in 1957 and revised by the Forest Service Geomaterials Service Center utilizing 1976 field checked compilation guides. Revised information added using photogrammetric methods from 1:15,840 (1973) or 1:80,000 (1974) scale aerial photography.

This boundary description has been plotted on a 1-inch-equals-1-mile map entitled "Winegar Hole Wilderness Boundary Map," dated March 24, 1987, which is attached and made a part of this description.
