PLEASANT/LEMESURIER/INIAN ISLANDS WILDERNESS

The exterior boundary of the Pleasant/Lemesurier/Inian Islands Wilderness, Tongass National Forest, Alaska Region, April 30, 1991, as entered into the National Wilderness Preservation System by Public Law 101-626, November 28, 1990, in the State of Alaska:

The Pleasant/Lemesurier/Inian Islands Wilderness consists of three separate boundary subunits. Therefore, the Pleasant/Lemesurier/Inian Islands Wilderness shall therefore be described using separate boundary descriptions for Pleasant Island, Lemesurier Island and Inian Islands as described below.

Pleasant Island Subunit

Beginning at a point offshore of the east coast of Pleasant Island in Icy Passage, east of Noon Point and horizontal control station "Help", the exterior boundary is offshore of the Pleasant Island coastline and of variable distance from said coastline to include all federally-owned rocks, pinnacles, islets and islands above mean high tide immediately offshore or specifically named as follows: from offshore and east of horizontal control station "Help", proceeding southwesterly and westerly off the south coast of Pleasant Island to a point offshore of the south coast of Pleasant Island, south of horizontal control station "Boss 2" and north of Pleasant Island Reef in Icy Strait; thence, northwesterly offshore of the southwest coast of Pleasant Island to a point offshore and west of horizontal control station "Ant" on the westernmost tip of Pleasant Island; thence, northeasterly offshore of the northwest coast of Pleasant Island to a point offshore and north of horizontal control station "Reef", off the northernmost tip of Pleasant Island in Icy Passage; thence, southeasterly offshore of the northeast coast of Pleasant Island to a point offshore on the east coast of Pleasant Island, east of Noon Point and horizontal control station "Help", the point of beginning.

Lemesurier Island Subunit

Beginning at a point offshore of the north coast of Lemesurier Island in North Passage of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Dash", the exterior boundary is offshore of the Lemesurier Island coastline and of variable distance from said coastline to include all federally-owned rocks, pinnacles, islets and islands above mean high tide immediately offshore or specifically named as follows: from offshore and north of horizontal control station "Dash", proceeding southeasterly and southerly to a point offshore in Icy Strait, east of horizontal control station "Bad", on the southeasternmost tip of Lemesurier Island; thence, southwesterly and westerly encompassing Willoughby Cove and Jacks Cove, to a point offshore in South Passage of Icy Strait, south of horizontal control station "Yak", on the southwest coast of Lemesurier Island; thence, northwesterly and northeasterly to a point offshore in North Passage of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Gad", located on a small unnamed island off the northwest coast of Lemesurier Island; thence, northeasterly to a point offshore of the north coast of Lemesurier Island in North Passage of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Dash", the point of beginning.

Inian Islands Submit

Beginning at a point offshore of the northwesterlymost island of Inian Islands in North Inian Pass of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Ache", the exterior boundary is offshore of the Inian Islands coastline and of variable distance from said coastline to include all federally-owned rocks, pinnacles, islets and islands above mean high tide immediately offshore or specifically named as follows: from offshore and north of horizontal control station "Ache", proceeding easterly encompassing Inian Cove to a point offshore of the northeast tip of Inian Islands in North Inian Pass of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Lamp"; thence, southeasterly and southwesterly encompassing Earl Cove to a point offshore of the southernmost tip of the largest island of Inian Islands in South Inian Pass of Icy Strait, south of horizontal control station "Fake" and north of South Rock; thence, westerly encompassing Dad Rock, passing to the north of Point Lavina to a point offshore of the southwest point of Inian Islands in Cross Sound south of horizontal control station "Fog"; thence, northwesterly and easterly to a point offshore of the most northwesterly island of Inian Islands in North Inian Pass of Icy Strait, north of horizontal control station "Ache", the point of beginning.

The Pleasant/Lemesurier/Inian Islands Wilderness contains 23,096 acres of National Forest land. Within the exterior boundaries of the Wilderness, there are an additional 55 acres of alienated lands.
