GRANITE MOUNTAIN WILDERNESS

A tract of land within the administrative boundary of the Prescott National Forest in Yavapai County, State of Arizona, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25, and 26, Township 15 North, Range 3 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian;

Thence, southerly between Sections 25 and 26 for approximately 0.23 miles to a point 300 feet south of the bottom of Mint Wash;

Thence, southeasterly and turning southwesterly for approximately 3.73 miles, 300 feet west of and parallel to the bottom of Mint Wash to a point 200 feet from the dam on Granite Basin Lake;

Thence, southwesterly for approximately 0.04 miles to a point that is 200 feet north of the dam on Granite Basin Lake;

Thence, westerly for approximately 0.24 miles, parallel to and 200 feet from the high water mark of Granite Basin Lake and turning northwesterly, remaining 200 feet from and parallel to the first drainage encountered, for approximately 0.23 miles to a point N. 45° E. from the end of Forest Road No. 374B;

Thence, in a counterclockwise direction, for approximately 0.05 miles, remaining 200 feet from the end of Forest Road No. 374B, crossing a drainage and Forest Trail No. 40 to a point S. 45° W. and 200 feet from the end of Forest Road No. 374B;

Thence, southeasterly for approximately 0.31 miles, remaining 200 feet from and parallel to Forest Road No. 374B to the northwest edge of Forest Trail No. 40;

Thence, southwesterly for approximately 1.68 miles, along the northwest edge of Forest Service Trail No. 40 to the junction of Forest Service Trail No. 37;

Thence, northerly for approximately 2.64 miles, along the East edge of Forest Service Trail No. 37 to Blair Pass and the junction of Forest Service Trail Nos. 261, 37 and 39;

Thence, northwesterly for approximately 1.32 miles, along the northeast edge of Forest Service Trail No. 39 to the junction with Forest Service Trail No. 41;

Thence, northwesterly for approximately 2.79 miles, along the northeast edge of Forest Service Trail No. 41 to a point 33 feet from the end of Forest Road No. 9400N;

Thence, northwesterly for approximately 1.57 miles, 33 feet northeast of and parallel to the centerline of Forest Road No. 9400N to a point 100 feet from Forest Road No. 676;

Thence, northeasterly for approximately 0.29 miles, 100 feet from and parallel to Forest Road No. 676 to a point 100 feet from Shroder Tank;

Thence, in a counterclockwise direction, 100 feet from and parallel to Shroder Tank for approximately 0.17 miles, to a point 100 feet from the centerline of Forest Road No. 676;

Thence, northeasterly for approximately 3.42 miles, 100 feet from and parallel to the centerline of Forest Service Road 671 to a point where the road intersects the south line of Lot 7, Section 16, T. 15 N., R. 3 W.;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.32 miles, on the south line of Lot 7 and 8 to the North 1/16 corner for Section 16 only, Township 15 North, Range 3 West;

Thence, northerly for approximately 0.07 miles, along the line between Sections 15 and 16, to the North 1/16 corner for Section 15 only;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.34 miles, along the east-west 1/16 line of the northwest one-quarter of Section 15, to the center-north 1/16 corner of Section 15;

Thence, southerly for approximately 0.25 miles, along the mid-section line of Section 15 to the center 1/4 corner of Section 15;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.51 miles, along the mid-section line of Section 15 to the 1/4 corner for Sections 14 and 15;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.24 miles, along the mid-section line of Section 14 to the center-west 1/16 corner of Section 14;

Thence, southerly for approximately 0.52 miles, along the north-south southwest 1/16 line to the west 1/16 corner on the south boundary of Section 14;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.23 miles, along the line between Sections 14 and 23 to the north 1/4 corner of Section 23 only;

Thence, southerly for approximately 0.71 miles, along the mid-section line of Section 23 to the center-south 1/16 corner of Section 23;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.26 miles, to the southeast 1/16 corner of Section 23;

Thence, southerly for approximately 0.26 miles, along the north-south, southeast 1/16 line to the east 1/16 corner between Sections 23 and 26;

Thence, easterly for approximately 0.26 miles, between Sections 23 and 24 to the point of beginning.

Lands herein described and topographic features referred to are depicted on 7 1/2 minute United States Geological Survey Quadrangle Sheets Iron Springs and Jerome Canyon dated 1979. These quadrangle sheets are intended to be an integral part of the legal description. The total area of the Granite Mountain Wilderness is 9,799 acres, more or less.
