SUPERSTITION WILDERNESS

The Exterior Boundary of Superstition Wilderness, Tonto National Forest, Southwestern Region, as reported to Congress pursuant to Section 3(a)(1) of the Wilderness Act, (Public Law 88-577)

Description

Beginning at a point on the Forest Boundary which is the southwest corner of section 28, T. 1 N., R. 9 E., Gila and Salt River Principal Meridian, Arizona; thence north 1.00 mile along the Forest Boundary to the northwest corner of section 28, T. 1 N., R. 9 E.; thence west 1.00 mile along the Forest Boundary to the southwest corner of section 20, T. 1 N., R. 9 E.; thence north 4.00 miles to the northwest corner of section 5, T. 1 N., R. 9 E.; thence east 1.00 mile to the northeast corner of section 5, T. 1 N., R. 9 E.; thence north 3.00 miles; thence east 7.00 miles; thence southeasterly and northeasterly 2.40 miles staying .50 mile west of Tortilla Creek, crossing the Creek N. 33°05' E., 2.66 miles to Black Cross Triangulation Station; thence northeasterly, north and northwesterly 2.60 miles staying .50 mile east of Tortilla Creek to a point N. 74°55' E., 1.92 miles to Black Cross Triangulation Station; thence north .62 mile; thence east 3.54 miles; thence north 1.00 mile; thence east 1.00 mile; thence north .57 mile; thence southeasterly, east, northeasterly, west and northwesterly 17.00 miles staying .50 mile on either side of Road No. 12212 leading to the Reeves Ranch, HES 412 and around the Reeves Ranch to a point N. 12°15' E., 1.08 miles to Davis Triangulation Station; thence north .30 mile; thence east 2.00 miles; thence north 2.00 miles; thence east 6.00 miles; thence south 5.93 miles; thence east 1.00 mile; thence south 5.04 miles; thence west 5.58 miles; thence south 1.00 mile; thence west 2.00 miles; thence south .87 mile; thence northwesterly, southwesterly, southeasterly, south and

westerly 4.25 miles staying just northeast and .50 mile northwest of Woodbury Cabin and .50 mile northwest and just southwest of the J.F. Ranch, to a point where the head of Millsite Canyon runs onto the ridge; thence southwesterly 4.12 miles along the ridge to a point on the Forest Boundary which is .20 mile north of the southeast corner of section 36, T. 1 N., R. 10 E.; thence north .80 mile along the Forest Boundary which is also the east township line of T. 1 N., R. 10 E., to the northeast corner of section 36, T. 1 N., R. 10 E.; thence west 4.00 miles along the Forest Boundary to the southwest corner of section 28, T. 1 S., R. 10 E.; thence north 1.00 mile to the northwest corner of section 28, T. 1 S., R. 10 E.; thence west 1.00 mile to the northeast corner of section 30, T. 1 S., R. 10 E.; thence south 1.00 mile to a point on the Forest Boundary which is the southeast corner of section 30, T. 1 S., R. 10 E.; thence west 5.00 miles along the Forest Boundary to the southwest corner of section 28, T. 1 N., R. 9 E., which is the point of beginning, containing 124,140 acres ^{1/} more or less.
