Boundary Description

Beginning at a point on the crest of the ridge approximately 0.18 mi. east of the SW corner of section 32, T. 2 N., R. 7 W., S.B.M. the Cucamonga Wilderness boundary runs easterly along the south line of sections 32, 33, 34 and 35 to the SE corner of section 35; thence northerly along the eastern line of section 35 to the NE corner of said section; thence in an easterly direction along the southern line of section 25 to the SE corner of said section; thence northerly along the eastern line of sections 25, 24, 13 and 12 to the NE corner of section 12; thence westerly along the northern line of sections 12 and 11 to the NW corner of section 11; thence southerly along the western line of section 11 to the western quarter corner of section 11; thence on a bearing of S 89°47'W for a distance of approximately 0.72 mi. to the prominent ridge in the SW quarter of Section 10; thence southerly along the crest over Telegraph Peak, the top of Timber mountain, Bighorn Peak and Ontario Peak to the point of beginning.

The above description is as shown on the 1 inch equals--1 mile map which is attached to and made a part of this description.
