One wilderness in Idaho under Public Law 111-11, March 30, 2009:

- Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness, Salmon-Challis National Forest

One wilderness in California under Public Law 111-11, March 30, 2009:

- South Fork San Jacinto Wilderness, San Bernardino National Forest

Two wildernesses in California under Public Law 109-362, October 17, 2006:

- Mount Lassic Wilderness, Six Rivers National Forest
- Sanhedrin Wilderness, Mendocino National Forest
