


NATIONAL WILDERNESS PRESERVATION SYSTEM

RAGGEDS WILDERNESS

Gunnison and White River National Forests, Colorado

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Beginning at a point on the summit of Purple Mountain (elevation 12,958 feet) on the boundary of the White River and Gunnison National Forests, Colorado, latitude 38°59'30", longitude 107°06'10";

thence southerly on the hydrographic divide between Anthracite Creek and Slate River 5.8 miles to the summit of Purple Peak (contour elevation 12,800 feet);

thence southerly on the hydrographic divide between Silver, Gold, and Dyke Creeks and Ruby Anthracite Creek 1.8 miles to a summit with elevation 11,832 feet;

thence southerly on said hydrographic divide less than 0.1 mile to the lowest point in a saddle between said summit and the northernmost summit with a contour elevation of 11,760 feet, said saddle being at the head of Dyke Creek;

thence westerly 2.5 miles on the thread of Dyke Creek to its confluence with Ruby Anthracite Creek;

thence northerly 0.1 mile on the thread of Ruby Anthracite Creek to the confluence of an unnamed, easterly-flowing tributary of said Creek at elevation 8,220 feet;

thence southwesterly 0.2 mile on the thread of said tributary to the intersection of a line 1,500 feet east of and parallel to Gunnison County Road No. 12 (Kebler Pass Road);

thence northwesterly on said line 5.8 miles to the west boundary line of Section 17, T.13S., R.88W., 6th P.M.;

thence northerly 2.5 miles on the west boundary line of Sections 17, 8, and 5 of said township to the northwest corner of said Section 5;

thence due north less than 0.1 mile to the hydrographic divide between Munsey Creek and Anthracite Creek;

thence northeasterly on said hydrographic divide 1.3 miles to a summit with a contour elevation of 8,800 feet;

thence 2.2 miles in straight lines through points with the following UTM coordinates:

thence westerly in a straight line 0.1 mile to the 10,000 foot elevation on the hydrographic divide between two unnamed, intermittent westerly-flowing tributaries joining Munsey Creek at 7,670 and 7,710 feet in elevation;

thence westerly 0.8 mile on said hydrographic divide to the intersection of the east boundary line of the west 1/2 of the east 1/2 of Section 29, T.12S., R.88W.;

thence northerly in a straight line 0.9 mile to the northeast corner of the southwest 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of Section 20 of said township;

thence westerly in a straight line 1.0 mile to the northwest corner of the southeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of Section 19 of said township;

thence northwesterly in a straight line 1.4 miles to a summit with an elevation of 8,697 feet;

thence northerly in a straight line 0.8 mile to a summit with an elevation of 9,190 feet in Section 13, T.12S., R.89W.;

thence northwesterly in a straight line 0.7 mile to a summit with an elevation of 9,085 feet;

thence N33°W 2.7 miles to the intersection of the thread of an unnamed, intermittent, westerly-flowing tributary joining Buck Creek at 6,930 feet in elevation;

thence easterly on the thread of said tributary 0.3 mile to its fork at elevation 9,160 feet;

thence easterly on the thread of the south fork of said tributary 0.3 mile to elevation of 10,000 feet;

thence northwesterly 0.5 mile on the 10,000 foot contour to the thread of an unnamed, intermittent tributary of Buck Creek at latitude 39°03'34", longitude 107°18'34";

thence easterly in a straight line 0.3 mile to a summit with an elevation of 11,126 feet;

thence northwesterly on the hydrographic divide separating drainage into Buck Creek above and below the confluence at elevation 8,630 of an unnamed, intermittent tributary, 0.5 mile to elevation 9,800 feet;

thence northeasterly on the 9,800 foot contour 0.5 mile to the intersection of the thread of an unnamed, intermittent tributary joining Buck Creek at 8,710 feet in elevation;

thence northeasterly on the thread of said tributary and its south fork less than 0.1 mile to elevation 10,000 feet;

thence northerly on the 10,000 foot contour less than 0.1 mile to the intersection of the east-west centerline of Section 26 Township 11 South, Range 89 West;

thence easterly on the east-west centerline of said section and Section 25 0.8 mile to the hydrographic divide between East Muddy Creek and Crystal River on the Gunnison and White River National Forest boundary;

thence easterly in a straight line, leaving said Forest boundary, 0.7 mile to a summit with an elevation of 11,866 feet;

thence northeasterly on the hydrographic divide between Rapid Creek and Chair Creek 0.6 mile to a summit with a contour elevation of 11,200 feet;

thence easterly in a straight line 1.8 miles to the northwest 1/16 corner of Section 28, T.11S., R.88W.;

thence easterly on the subdivision-of-section line 0.5 mile to the northeast sixteenth corner of said section;

thence southerly on the subdivision-of-section line 0.25 mile to the center-east sixteenth corner of said section;

thence easterly on the east-west centerline of Sections 28 and 27 of said township 1.25 miles to the east line of Section 27;

thence southerly on the section line 0.25 mile to the south sixteenth corner of Sections 27 and 26 of said township;

thence easterly on the subdivision-of-section line 0.6 mile to the center-west-southeast sixty-fourth corner of Section 26;

thence southerly on the subdivision-of-section line 0.1 mile to the southwest-southeast sixty-fourth corner of said section;

thence easterly on the subdivision-of-section line 0.6 mile to the intersection of a line 300 feet west of and parallel to the centerline of Yule Creek Road;

thence southeasterly on said line 0.1 mile to a point on the line between corners #5 and #6 of Mineral Survey (MS) #9618 in Section 36 of said township;

thence westerly in a straight line 0.1 mile to corner #6 of said MS 9618;

thence southerly in a straight line 0.3 mile to corner #7 of said MS 9618;

thence easterly on a straight line between corners #7 and #8 of said MS 9618 0.1 mile to the intersection of a line 300 feet west of and parallel to Yule Creek Road;

thence southerly on said line 1.3 miles to the intersection of the north boundary line of lot 23 of Section 1, T.12S., R.88W.;

thence westerly on said line 0.1 mile to the northwest corner of said lot 23 of said section;

thence southerly 0.5 mile to the southwest corner of lot 4 of Section 12 of said township;

thence easterly on the prolongation of a line through the southeast corner of lot 1 of said section 0.9 mile to the intersection of UTM 312,956 meter coordinate line;

thence 1.2 miles in straight lines through points with the following UTM coordinates:

thence easterly in a straight line 0.2 mile to a summit with elevation 12,287 feet on the hydrographic divide between Yule Creek and Crystal River;

thence southeasterly on said hydrographic divide 3.8 miles to summit with a contour elevation of 13,240 feet on the boundary line between the Gunnison and White River National Forests;

thence southerly on said boundary line and the hydrographic divide between Yule Creek and Slate River 1.5 miles to the point of beginning;

Containing the following acreage:
