

## BRASSTOWN WILDERNESS ADDITION

### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The Brasstown Wilderness Addition is located on the south boundary of the Brasstown Wilderness, Chattahoochee National Forest, Brasstown Ranger District, Union County, Georgia. The addition lies about (5) miles southeast of Young Harris, Georgia and about (6) miles southwest of Hiawassee, Georgia. The Exterior Boundary of the Brasstown Wilderness, which includes the Wilderness Addition was entered into the National Wilderness Preservation System by the "Chattahoochee Forest Protection Act (Georgia Wilderness)", Public Law 102-217, December 11, 1991.

The Wilderness Boundary Addition is delineated on the U.S.G.S. 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2 minute Georgia quadrangle Jacks Gap, Ga. 1957 Base Map, 1986 Correction Guide (Modified for USDA Forest Service use). Where actual field survey bearings and distances were not available, courses were digitized from the Georgia State Plane Coordinate System, West Zone, using the above named quads, and therefore should be considered approximate. Survey bearings are based on True North and digitized bearings are based on Grid North.

BEGINNING AT POINT 1AD, a point in the junction of Indian Camp Creek and Tom Branch in the SE corner of Land Lot No. 210, District 16, Section 1 of Union County;

Thence leaving the junction of Indian Camp Creek and Tom Branch N61°56'W, 3,046 feet (digitized) to Point #2AD, a point on top of an unnamed knob in the NE part of Land Lot No. 205 with an elevation of 3,145 feet above sea level;

Thence N89°17'W, 4,451 feet (digitized) to Point 3AD, being Point #13A of the Original Wilderness Boundary, a point in Land Lot No. 186, approximately 500 feet west of Wimpy Branch and approximately 800 feet NE of the terminal point of Forest Development Road No. 292;

Thence in a northeast direction ascending along the crest of a ridge of Rocky Mountain that is southeast of Bald Creek with the Original Wilderness Boundary the following digitized courses:
