**FRANK CHURCH RIVER OF NO RETURN WILDERNESS
SUBTRACTION No. 1 AND ADDITION No. 1**

The area included in the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness Subtraction and Addition is located within the Salmon-Challis National Forest, Intermountain Region, Custer County, Idaho, and conforms to the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 (PL 111-11, Section 3308, March 30, 2009). The official boundary description and final map on which the boundaries are shown are on file and available in the offices of the Chief of the Forest Service, Washington, DC, the office of the Intermountain Regional Forester, Ogden, Utah, and the office of the Forest Supervisor, Salmon-Challis National Forest, Salmon, Idaho. The portion of the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness subtraction and addition within National Forest System Land as described here consists of an approximate ground area of 10.06 acres subtracted and 10.06 acres added. Dimensions were computed from land survey measurements, Geographic Coordinate Data Base (GCDB) information, and 1:24,000 scale, 7½ minute quadrangle maps using the Forest's Geographic Information System (GIS). A detailed description of the boundaries follow.

***FRANK CHURCH RIVER OF NO RETURN WILDERNESS SUBTRACTION No. 1
LEGAL DESCRIPTION***

Boise Meridian, Idaho

Situated in the Challis National Forest, Custer County, Idaho, within unsurveyed section 15, Township (T) 14 North, Range (R) 13 East, Boise Meridian (BM).

COMMENCING at corner 8, Homestead Entry Survey (HES) 135, in unsurveyed section 15, T. 14 N., R. 13 E., BM, and running thence South 64°16'31" West a distance of 337.36 feet more or less to a 300 foot southwesterly offset of the line formed by corners 1 and 8, said HES 135, at a point marked by a standard U.S. Forest Service 3 1/4 inch aluminum cap at approximately 44°33'09.608" north latitude and 114°51'33.182" west longitude being the POINT OF BEGINNING for this description;

thence running South 52° 56' 40" East a distance of 280.07 feet along said southwesterly offset to the point of intersection with a 300 feet southerly offset of the line formed by corners 7 and 8, said HES 135;

thence along said southerly offset North 81°34'06" East, a distance of 860.81 feet to the point of intersection with a 300 foot northwesterly offset of the line formed by corners 4 and 5, HES 74, said point being at approximately 44°33'02.116" north latitude and 114°51'24.913" west longitude;

thence along said northwesterly offset South 47°04'00" West a distance of 501.63 feet to the point of intersection with a 300 foot northwesterly offset of the line formed by corners 3 and 4, HES 74;

thence along said northwesterly offset South $51^{\circ}50'32''$ West a distance of 900.09 feet more or less to the point of intersection with a 300 foot northwesterly offset of the line formed by corners 2 and 3, HES 74, said point being marked by a standard U.S. Forest Service 3 1/4 inch aluminum cap;

thence NORTH a distance of 940.34 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above-described parcel contains 10.06 acres. The location of Subtraction No. 1 is on Page 59, Line 6 of the original Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness Boundary Description.

***FRANK CHURCH RIVER OF NO RETURN WILDERNESS ADDITION No. 1
LEGAL DESCRIPTION***

Boise Meridian, Idaho

Situated in the Challis National Forest, Custer County, Idaho, within unsurveyed section 15, Township (T) 14 North, Range (R) 13 East, Boise Meridian.

BEGINNING at the confluence of No Name Creek and Loon Creek at approximately $44^{\circ}31'44.39''$ north latitude and $114^{\circ}51'37.12''$ west longitude and running thence easterly a distance of 1,195 feet more or less to a point at approximately 6,160 feet in elevation at approximately $44^{\circ}31'44.08''$ north latitude and $114^{\circ}51'20.63''$ west longitude;

thence southerly along an approximate contour of 6,160 feet a distance of 320 feet more or less to a point on the existing Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness at approximately $44^{\circ}31'41.03''$ north latitude and $114^{\circ}51'20.74''$ west longitude;

thence westerly along said existing boundary a distance of 1,425 feet more or less to a point at approximately 6,000 feet in elevation;

thence northerly along an approximate 6,000 foot contour a distance of 310 feet more or less to a point at approximately $44^{\circ}31'44.45''$ north latitude and $114^{\circ}51'40.28''$ west longitude;

thence easterly a distance of 230 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above-described parcel contains approximately 10.06 acres. The location of Addition No. 1 is on Page 59, Line 13 of the original Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness Boundary Description.

Qualifications:

The bearings used in these descriptions are true bearings based on a solar observation taken at corner 8 HES 135; the distances used are ground distances at a mean project elevation of 6,100 feet.

The coordinates for certain corner positions and cadastral project control were determined by survey quality Global Positioning System (GPS) observations based on solutions returned by the National Geodetic Survey Online Positioning User Service for GPS files collected on July 29, 2009. Where the wilderness boundary is monumented, the location of the survey monument is the true location of the wilderness boundary. The monument coordinate data is provided as an aid to locate monuments in the field.

A Record of Survey of the subtraction parcel was filed with the Custer County Idaho Records office as document No. 242385, filed at 2:59 pm on April 7, 2010.
