

CLIFTY WILDERNESS  
BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The Clifty Wilderness is located on the Daniel Boone National Forest, in Manifee and Wolfe counties, Kentucky.

All bearings were digitized from the Kentucky State Plane Coordinate System, North Zone from USGS, 1:24,000 scale 7 1/2 minute topographic quads. Pomeroyton and Scranton, (modified for USDA Forest Service use). Bearings are referenced from Grid North and expressed in degrees and minutes.

All distances are map distances that were digitized from the preceding named quads, and therefore should be considered as approximate.

THE POINT OF BEGINNING and Point #1, a point which is Corner 27 of U.S. Tract #C-5;

Thence northwesterly approximately 4,700 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-5 to Point #2, a point where the boundary intersects the SW corner of U.S. Tract #C-5-I;

Thence approximately 5,583 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-5-I to Point #3, the NW corner of U.S. Tract #C-5-I where it intersects the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-5;

Thence northerly approximately 7,362 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-5 to Point #4, a point where the boundary intersects the eastern boundary U.S. Tract #C-326;

Thence northerly approximately 2,316 feet along the eastern boundary of U.S. Tract #C-326 to Point #5, a point where the eastern boundary of U.S. Tract #C-326 intersects the eastern boundary of U.S. Tract #C-8;

Thence approximately 11,191 feet along the SE boundary of U.S. Tract #C-8 to Point #6, a point where the SE boundary of U.S. Tract #C-8 intersects the south boundary of U.S. Tract #C-3179;

Thence northerly approximately 791 feet along the south boundary of U.S. Tract #C-3179 to Point #7, which is Corner 8 of U.S. Tract #C-3179;

Thence southeasterly approximately 282 feet across private land to Point #8, a point in the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-9 and approximately 200 feet south of Corner 10 of U.S. Tract #C-9;

Thence approximately 5,087 feet along the south boundary of U.S. Tract #C-9 to Point #9, a point where the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-9 intersects the boundary of U.S. Tract #272;

Thence approximately 3,236 feet along the south and northeast boundary of U.S. Tract #C-272 to Point #10, the point where U.S. Tract #C-272 intersects at Corner 9 of U.S. Tract #C-9, and is also on the National Forest Boundary;

Thence in a northerly and northwesterly direction approximately 31,629 feet along the National Forest Boundary to Point #11, a point where the NE corner of U.S. Tract #C-571 intersects the National Forest Boundary;

Thence southwesterly approximately 566 feet along the north line of U.S. Tract #C-571 to Point #11A, a point where the north line intersects the east boundary of U.S. Tract #C-311;

Thence northwesterly approximately 3,898 feet along the east and north boundary of U.S. Tract #C-311 to Point #12, a point where the north boundary of U.S. Tract #C-311 intersects the east boundary of U.S. Tract #C-751;

Thence northwesterly approximately 2,701 feet along the northeast boundary of U.S. Tract #C-751 to Point #13, a point where the north line of U.S. Tract #C-751 intersects the east boundary of U.S. Tract #C-24;

Thence northerly approximately 3,216 feet along the east line of U.S. Tract #C-24 to Point #14, a point where the east line of U.S. Tract #C-24 intersects the National Forest Boundary;

Thence in a northerly direction approximately 54,530 feet along the National Forest Boundary to Point #15, at a point where the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-24a leaves the National Forest Boundary near the intersection of State Highway #746 and Landsaw Branch;

Thence in a southwesterly and then a northwesterly direction approximately 16,826 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-24a to Point #16, at the point of intersection with the north boundary of U.S. Tract #C-82;

Thence in a westerly, southerly and easterly direction approximately 5,530 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-82 to Point #17, a point where the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-82 intersects the west boundary of U.S. Tract #C-24a;

Thence southerly approximately 17,964 feet along the west boundary U.S. Tract #C-24a to Point #18, a point where the boundary intersects the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-4;

Thence in a northwesterly and southwesterly direction approximately 39,118 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #C-4 to Point #19, a point that intersects the east boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-85a,b);

Thence in a northwesterly direction approximately 4,248 feet along the boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-85a,b) to Point #20, at a point where the boundary intersects the northwesterly boundary of U.S. Tract #C-4;

Thence southwesterly approximately 48,221 feet along the northwesterly boundary of U.S. Tract #C-4 to Point #21, which is Corner #19 of U.S. Tract #C-4;

Thence southeasterly approximately 9,614 feet along the cliff line south of Meadow Branch to Point #22, a point that intersects at Corner 28 of U.S. Tract #C-4 and on the north boundary of U.S. Tract #C-97;

Thence westerly and southwesterly approximately 6,344 feet along the northern and western boundary of U.S. Tract #C-97 to Point #23, a point where the western boundary of U.S. Tract #C-97 intersects the northern boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-13a);

Thence northwesterly and then southeasterly approximately 3,827 feet along the northerly and southwesterly boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-13a) to Point #24, a point which is Corner #3 of U.S. Tract #(C-13a);

Thence in a northeasterly direction approximately 622 feet to Point #25, a point which is Corner #1 of U.S. Tract #(C-13a) also Corners #1 on U.S. Tract #C-97 and U.S. Tract #(C-13);

Thence northeasterly approximately 564 feet along the south boundary of U.S. Tract #C-13 to Point #26, at the point of intersection with the north boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a) which is Corner #1 of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a);

Thence southwesterly approximately 1,001 feet along the northwesterly boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a) to Point #27, which is Corner #8 of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a);

Thence southwesterly approximately 962 feet along the westerly boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a) to Point #28;

Thence in a southwesterly direction approximately 1,576 feet to Point #29, a point on the cliff line and on the southeastern boundary of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a);

Thence in a southwesterly direction approximately 1,822 feet along the cliff line and the southeastern boundary of said tract to Point #30, a point which is Corner #4 of U.S. Tract #(C-1758a), also intersects the southeast boundary of Tract #(C-3164);

Thence in a southwesterly direction approximately 2,130 feet along the southeast boundary of Tract #(C-3164) to Point #31, a point 100 feet north of the centerline of State Road #715;

Thence in a southerly direction approximately 47,233 feet along a line 100 feet north and east of and parallel to the centerline of State Road #715 so as exclude private land along road to Point #32, a point 100 feet northerly of the centerline of State Road #715 and the centerline of Forest Service Road #24;

Thence easterly approximately 16,138 feet along a line 100 feet northerly of and parallel to the centerline of Forest Service Road #24 to Point #33, a concrete marker 100 feet northwesterly of the centerline of Forest Service Road #24 at the fork of the Loop Road;


Thence along a line 100 feet northeasterly of and parallel to the centerline of the Loop Road approximately 722 feet to Point #34, a point 100 feet east of the Loop Road and on the cliff line north of Forest Service Trail #207 which is Rock Bridge Nature Trail;

Thence northeasterly along the cliff line north of Rock Bridge Nature Trail approximately 1,797 feet to Point #35, a point on Swift Creek Trail which is Forest Service Trail #219;

Thence southeasterly approximately 1,194 feet down the northeast side of a ridge passing the junction of Swift Camp Creek and Chestnut Log Branch to point #1 and THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

The Clifty Wilderness containing in aggregate 12,646 acres more or less.
