In accordance with Section 3(b) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (82 Stat. 906 as amended; 16 U.S.C. 1274), we are pleased to forward the detailed boundary for the Black River in Michigan, added to the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System by Public Law 102-249, March 3, 1992. This boundary will not become effective until 90 days from the date of this letter.

This boundary description is the result of extensive public involvement during preparation of the river management plan for the river (*Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact, Environmental Assessment, July 13, 2007, for the Black River*).
