


NATIONAL WILDERNESS PRESERVATION SYSTEM

DESCRIPTION OF THE GREAT GULF WILDERNESS

WHITE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL FOREST EASTERN REGION

October 30, 1959

A portion of U. S. Tract No. 14, White Mountain National Forest, located in Thompson and Meserves Purchase, Sargents Purchase, and Pinkhams Grant, Coos County, New Hampshire and more specifically described as follows:

Beginning 0.001 mile south from the intersection of the Great Gulf Trail and the west bound of Greens Grant; thence south following the west bound of Greens Grant 1.33 miles to a point 0.063 miles north of the Mt. Washington Auto Road; thence in a westerly direction parallel to and 0.063 miles north from the Mt. Washington Auto Road 6.56 miles to the intersection of the Great Gulf Trail and the Gulfside Trail; thence in a northerly direction parallel to and 0.001 mile east and south from the Gulfside and Israel Ridge Trails and Lowe's Path 4.45 miles to the summit of Mt. Adams; thence in a northerly direction parallel to and 0.001 mile east from the Star Lake and Parapet Trails 0.90 mile to the junction of the Osgood and Parapet Trails; thence in an easterly direction parallel to and 0.001 mile south from the Osgood Trail 0.45 mile to the summit of Mt. Madison; thence in a southerly direction parallel to and 0.001 mile west and south from the Osgood Trail 3.23 miles to the Great Gulf Trail; thence in an easterly direction parallel to an 0.001 mile south from the Great Gulf Trail 0.20 mile to the point of beginning, containing 5,552 acres, more or less 1/.

As shown on the 1 inch-equals-1 mile planimetric map designated "The Exterior Boundary of the Great Gulf Wilderness, White Mountain National Forest, Northern Peaks Area" which is attached to and made a part of this description.

1/ The entire Wilderness is in National Forest ownership.
