Dear Madam President:

In accordance with Section 3(b) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (82 Stat. 906 as amended; 16 U.S.C. 1274), we are pleased to forward the final maps and perimeter boundary descriptions for the following Wild and Scenic Rivers:

- Crescent Creek Wild and Scenic River, in Oregon, added to the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System by Public Law 100-557, October 28, 1988. This river is administered by the Deschutes National Forest.
- Upper White Salmon Wild and Scenic River, in Washington, added to the National Wild and Scenic River System by Public Law 109-44, August 2, 2005. This river is administered by the Gifford Pinchot National Forest.
