BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION
CRESCENT CREEK WILD AND SCENIC RIVER

This Wild and Scenic River was designated by Public Law (P.L.) 100-557 dated October 28, 1988. This description and the final map, attached hereto and made a part hereof, shall be considered as if contained in the original legislation creating this scenic river, and shall govern all boundaries of the area.

In the following description, where called, all cited United States Public Land Survey System (PLSS), land boundaries and corners; other calls to or along any senior boundary line, calls to or along natural or topographic features; as described in the narrative description portion of this document, shall be considered as controlling positions and shall prevail over any bearing, distance or geographic position cited within this description. Unless specifically identified, calls to streams shall be to the thread, calls to a road centerline shall be as built, and calls to a ridge shall be to the crest.

Section, Township and Range lines and Section corners, established by the PLSS, shall determine the actual location of these portions of the boundary so described. Section subdivision lines and corners will be established under the rules of the PLSS. Where a monument for a corner is called for, the corner point marked by said monument shall control the location of the boundary, recognizing the fact that a monument may have been perpetuated with a newer monument. Positions with a Latitude and Longitude are listed in WGS 1984.

All bearings and distances shown in the following description are derived from geographic positions which are based on the North American Datum of 1983 projection in International feet.

The corridor generally traverses portions of:

Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 of T. 24 S., R. 6 E., W.M.

Sections 6, 7, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, and 22 of T. 24 S., R. 7 E., W.M.

NARRATIVE

T. 24 S., R. 6 E., W.M.

Point 1

Beginning at the One-quarter corner between Sections 1 and 2, T. 24 S., R. 6 E., as established by the GLO in 1915;

Thence, easterly to;

Point 2

The Center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 1, as determined by County Survey (CS) 5017 by Robert M. Karl, PLS 1642; filed Nov. 23, 1990, in which he confirmed a position established in CS 1038, by Lyle Smith, PE 3851, filed Sept. 17, 1965.

Thence, easterly to;

Point 3

The $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 1, T. 24 S., R. 6 E and of Section 6, T. 24 S., R. 7 E., as established by the General land Office (GLO) in 1915.

T. 24 S., R. 7 E., W.M.

Thence, easterly to;

Point 4

A point on the westerly Right-of-Way (ROW) line of State Highway 58 and on the East/West centerline of Section 6, per afore mentioned CS 5017.

Thence, Southerly along the westerly ROW line of said Highway to;

Point 5

A point on the westerly ROW line of State Highway 58 where an extension of the southerly Easement line for County Road 61 would intersect said ROW. According to a Special Use Agreement between Klamath County, Oregon and the U.S. Forest Service, the easement for County Road 61 is 66 feet wide, with such additional width as necessary for maintenance of cuts and fills. Thus, the easement line is 33 feet from the as-built centerline of said County Road 61, which is also known as The Crescent Cutoff Road;

Thence, Northerly along the extension of said easement to;

Point 6

A point at the intersection of the northern ROW line of Highway 58 and the Southeasterly Easement of County Road 61;

Thence, Easterly on the Southerly Easement line of said County Road 61 to;

Point 7

A point on the line between Sections 13 and 14, approximately 1120 feet South of the corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 & 14 and on the southerly Easement of County Road 61. Said point is approximately 2300 feet southeasterly of the intersection of County Road 61 with County Road 46, the Cascades Lakes Highway. Said Point 7 having the approximate coordinates of Lat. $43^{\circ}29'52.6''$ N; and Long. $121^{\circ}50'34.5''$ W.

Thence, Southerly along said section line to;

Point 8

The one quarter corner of Sections 13 and 14, T. 24 S., R. 7 E.; shown on CS 7939 by David Armstrong, PLS 1026, filed Sept. 24, 2012,

Thence, Westerly to;

Point 9

The Northeast propeliy comer of a private parcel, established and shown on CS 7939 by David Armstrong, PLS 1026, filed Sept. 24, 2012, said comer being identified as AP 1 on the E/W Centerline of Section 14, T. 24 S., R. 7 E.;

Thence, Southwesterly on a line to;

Point 10

A point on the centerline and at the end of Forest Road 5815-700, said point having the approximate location of Lat. $43^{\circ}29'33.0''$ N. and Long. $121^{\circ}51'11.0''$ W.;

Thence, Westerly along the centerline of said road to;

Point 11

A point on the centerline of said road, and on the line between Sections 14 and 15, T. 24 S., R. 7 E.;

Thence, Southwesterly on a line to;

Point 12

A point on the centerline of and at the northern end of Forest Road 5815-200, said point being approximately on the line between Sections 15 and 22;

Thence, Southwesterly along the centerline of said road for 2100 linear feet, to;

Point 13

A point on the centerline of said Forest Road 5815-200, said point having the approximate location of Lat. $43^{\circ} 28' 54.7''$ N. and Long. $121^{\circ} 52' 59.5''$ W.;

Thence, Southerly and Westerly along a line to;

Point 14

A point on the Centerline of State Highway 58, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile (1320 horizontal feet from the centerline/centerline intersection point where said Highway crosses Crescent Creek in The NW Quarter of Section 21, T. 24 S., R. 7 E.;

Thence, Westerly to;

Point 15

The CE $\frac{1}{16}$ corner of Section 20, T. 24 S., R. 7 E., as established but not set by Bob Dorch, PLS 946, in CS 1626, filed Nov. 15, 1971.;

Thence, Northwesterly along a diagonal line in said Section 20 to;

Point 16

The corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, T. 24 S., R. 7 E.

Thence, Northwesterly to;

Point 17

A point on the North/South centerline of Section 18, T. 24 S., R. 7 E., which is the position of the unestablished Center-South 1116th corner, approximately 1320 feet north of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to sections 18 and 19;

Thence, Northwesterly on a line to;

Point 18

The corner of Sections 7 and 18, T. 24 S., R. 7 E. and Sections 12 and 13, T. 24 S., R. 6 E.

Thence, Northwesterly along a line to;

T. 24 S., R. 6 E., W.M.

Point 19

A point approximately on the North/South centerline Section 12. Said point is approximately 550 feet south along the said North/South centerline from the most Southerly braid of Crescent Creek, which flows during irrigation season; and is further defined by the approximate coordinates of Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 23.9''$ N; and Long. $121^{\circ} 57' 10.2''$ W.

Thence, Westerly and Southerly along a line to;

Point 20

A point on the centerline of Forest Road 6005-100 at the intersection of Forest Road 6005-105, a dirt road generally heading South from said Forest Road 6005-100 and further defined by the approximate coordinates of Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 19.5''$ N.; and Long. $121^{\circ} 58' 10.9''$ W.

Thence, Southwesterly along the centerline of Forest Road 6005-100 to;

Point 21

A point on the centerline of a Wye intersection in Forest Road 6005-100, said point being East of a point in the Centerline of Crescent Creek which is approximately 460 horizontal feet downstream from the northernmost point on the spillway of the Crescent Lake Dam. The approximate location of the point in the creek is Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 12.7''$ N.; and Long. $121^{\circ} 58' 22.5''$ W.

Thence, West through the said location in the Centerline of Crescent Creek to;

Point 22

A point on the centerline Forest Road 6000-180, further defined by the approximate coordinates of Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 12.6''$ N; and Long. $121^{\circ} 58' 29.1''$ W.

Thence, Northerly along the centerline of said Forest Road, to;

Point 23

A point at the centerline/centerline intersection of said Forest Road and County Road 60;

Thence, Northeasterly along the centerline of said County Road to;

Point 24

A point at the centerline/centerline intersection of County Road 60 and Forest Road 6005, said point being at approximately Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 32.6''$ N.; and Long. $121^{\circ} 58' 09.5''$ W.

Thence, Northwesterly along the centerline of said County Road 60 then Northeasterly along the centerline and across the railroad tracks to;

Point 25

A point on the centerline/centerline junction of County Road 60 and Forest Road 5800-620, also known as the Metolius-Windigo Trail #99, said point being at approximately Lat. $43^{\circ} 30' 46.9''$ N.; and Long. $121^{\circ} 58' 19.2''$ W.

Thence, Northwesterly and then Northeasterly along the centerline of said Forest Road 5800-620 to:

Point 26

A point on the centerline of Forest Road 5800-620 and on the line between Sections 1 and 2, T. 24 S., R. 6 E. which is approximately 320 feet South of the corner common to sections 1 & 2 and sections 35 & 36 in T. 23 S., R. 6 E.; said point being at approximately Lat. $43^{\circ} 31' 43''$ N.; and Long. $121^{\circ} 57' 46''$ W.

Thence, South along said section line to;

Point 27= Point 1

The One-quarter corner between Sections 1 and 2, T. 24 S., R. 6 E., as established by the GLO in 1915; The Point of Beginning.
