Dear Mr. Chairman:

In accordance with Section 3(b) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (82 Stat. 906 as amended; 16 U.S.C. 1274), we are pleased to forward the final maps and perimeter boundary descriptions for the following Wild and Scenic Rivers:

- Cache la Poudre Wild and Scenic River, in Colorado, added to the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System by Public Law 99-590, October 30, 1986. This river is administered by the Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests and the National Park Service, Rocky Mountain National Park.
- Three Wild and Scenic Rivers, in Oregon, added to the National Wild and Scenic River System by Public Law 111-11, March 30, 2009, and administered by the Mount Hood National Forest:
  - Eagle Creek Wild and Scenic River
  - Fish Creek Wild and Scenic River
  - Zig Zag Wild and Scenic River
