


NATIONAL WILDERNESS PRESERVATION SYSTEM

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

LYE BROOK WILDERNESS

BEGINNING at Corner 11 of the U. S. Tract 393 (Rich Lumber Company) in the center of Bourn Brook.

THENCE upstream with the centerline of said Bourn Brook as it meanders, easterly, 0.0799 mile to Corner 1 of the John D. and Kate R. Upton Tract 134a.

THENCE with the said Tract 134a, northeasterly, 0.34 mile to Corner 9 of the U. S. Tract 100 (Charles W. Nichols).

THENCE 3 lines with the said U. S. Tract 100:

1. Westerly, 0.08 mile to Corner 10.
2. Northerly, 0.20 mile to Corner 11.
3. Easterly, 0.13 mile to Corner 12.

THENCE passing through the said U. S. Tract 100, easterly, 0.08 mile to Corner 6.

THENCE with the said U. S. Tract 100, easterly, 0.12 mile to the intersection of said line and the westerly side line of the public right-of-way over Manchester Town Road No. 26 (Rootville Road).

THENCE with the said public right-of-way side line, southerly and easterly, 0.9 mile to the Manchester-Winhall Township Line.

THENCE with a side line running parallel with, and 1.5 rods south of the centerline of the said Rootville Road, easterly, 0.7 mile to the junction with the Burpee Brook Road.

THENCE with a side line running parallel with, and 1.5 rods south of the centerline of the said Burpee Brook Road, northeasterly, 0.4 mile to the center of Burpee Brook flowing southeasterly into the Winhall River.

THENCE downstream with the centerline of said brook as it meanders, southeasterly, 0.6 mile to the center of the Winhall River.

THENCE upstream with the centerline of the said Winhall River as it meanders, southerly, 4.6 miles to a fork in said river.

THENCE about S74°-00'W, 1.09 miles to a fork in the headwaters of Lye Brook.

THENCE about S63°-30'W, 0.99 mile to Corner 9 of the U. S. Tract 398 (St. Regis Paper Company).

THENCE westerly, 1.6 miles to Corner 17 of the said U. S. Tract 398.

THENCE 3 lines with the said U. S. Tract 398:

1. N87°-00'W, 0.2599 mile to Corner 18.
2. N86°-10'W, 0.2734 mile to Corner 19.
3. N83°-45'W, 0.0687 mile to Corner 20 which is Corner 29 of the U. S. Tract 393a (Rich Lumber Company).

THENCE with the said U. S. Tract 393a, N86°-30'W, 0.0687 mile to the center of a small brook flowing northerly.

THENCE downstream with the center of the said small brook as it meanders, northerly, 0.1 mile to the center of Mill Brook.

THENCE downstream with the center of the said Mill Brook as it meanders westerly and northerly, 1.4 miles to the east line of the easement of the proposed relocation of U. S. Route 7.

THENCE along said east easement line, northerly, 5.2 miles to the south bank of said Lye Brook.

THENCE along the south bank and the west bank of said Lye Brook, easterly and southerly, 0.4 mile to Corner 35 of the U. S. Tract 399 (Paul W. Glover).

THENCE with the said U. S. Tract 399, S0°-50'W, 0.0838 mile to Corner 34.

THENCE due east, 0.1 mile to line 8-9 of the said U. S. Tract 399.

THENCE with the said U. S. Tract 399, S2°-05'W, 0.1 mile to the northwest corner of a Louise W. Battick parcel.

THENCE with the north line of said Battick parcel, easterly, 0.2 mile to the northeast corner of said Battick parcel.

THENCE easterly, 0.2 mile to Corner 6 of the U. S. Tract 438 (Robert J. and Marie G. Romano).

THENCE with the north line of the said U. S. Tract 438, easterly, 0.2 mile to Corner 9 of the said U. S. Tract 393.

THENCE 2 lines with the said U. S. Tract 393:

1. N88°-50'E, 0.0552 mile to Corner 10.
2. N27°-50'E, 0.4622 mile to THE PLACE OF THE BEGINNING.
