Upper White Salmon Wild and Scenic Rivers Act of 2005

Public Law 109-44

This description and the accompanying final map are based on the Congressionally approved 20-miles of river segments of the main stem of the "White Salmon River" and the "Cascade Creek" for the creation of the Upper White Salmon Wild and Scenic River contained within the Upper White Salmon Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (Public Law 109-44) dated August 2, 2005. This description and the accompanying final map shall govern all boundaries of the Wild and Scenic River and shall be considered as if contained in the original legislation, P.L. 109-44. In the case of any conflicts found between the final map and this description, the final map shall govern the resolution thereto. The legislative limits of the four river segments were accurately mapped and the updated segment lengths are reported in the descriptions area statements, the designated segments total 22.6 river miles.

Parcel "A" – Wild Segment: "The approximately 1.6-mile segment of the main stem of the White Salmon River from the headwaters on Mount Adams in section 17, township 8 north, range 8 east, downstream to the Mount Adams Wilderness boundary as a wild river." (Public Law 109-44)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the main stem of the White Salmon River, situated in the state of Washington, County of Skamania, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington

T. 8 N., R. 10 E., unsurveyed.
secs. 16, 17, and 18;
protraction block 41.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at the true boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness, said end line shall be bounded by the same, and to end at its intersections with a circle, 1320 feet radius from its center at the easterly most point of the headwaters of the main stem of the White Salmon River, said end line shall be bounded by said circle, concave westerly, as designated under Public Law 109-44.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying outside the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 600 feet northerly of the centerline of the main stem of the White Salmon River and the westerly boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following fifteen courses:

- 1) North 69° 53' East, 1161 feet;
- 2) North 48° 31' East, 1617 feet;
- 3) North 40° 01' East, 1033 feet;
- 4) North 70° 00' East, 2276 feet;
- 5) North 54° 00' East, 1452 feet, more or less, to the line 660 feet northerly of the centerline of said White Salmon River;
- 6) easterly, along said line, 4750 feet, more or less, to the circle with a radius of 660 feet and the center at the easterly most point of the headwaters of said White Salmon River;
- 7) southerly, along said circle concave to the west, 1990 feet, more or less, to the line 660 feet southerly of the centerline of said White Salmon River;
- 8) westerly, along said line, 3530 feet;
- 9) South 48° 15' West, 1586 feet;
- 10) South 71° 55' West, 1087 feet;
- 11) South 66° 48' West, 1468 feet;
- 12) South 43° 28' West, 1331 feet;
- 13) South 59° 56' West, 907 feet;
- 14) South 65° 24' West, 1066 feet; and
- 15) South 53° 09' West, 1297 feet, more or less, to the westerly boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness.

The area described, comprising all of Parcel "A", contains 420 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 2.4 miles of the main stem of the White Salmon River. The bearings shown herein are geodetic, referenced to the true meridian, NAD 83 (2011).

Parcel "B" – Wild Segment: "The approximately 5.1-mile segment of Cascade Creek from its headwaters on Mount Adams in section 10, township 8 north, range 10 east, downstream to the Mount Adams Wilderness boundary as a wild river." (Public Law 109-44)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the main stem of the Cascade Creek, situated in the state of Washington, County of Skamania, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington

- T. 7 N., R. 10 E.,
secs. 5 and 6.
- T. 8 N., R. 10 E.,
secs. 28, 29, 31, and 32.
- T. 8 N., R. 10 E., unsurveyed.
secs. 9, 10, 15, 16, and 17;
protraction blocks 42 and 43.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at the true boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness, said end line shall be bounded by the same, and to end at its intersections with a circle, 1320 feet radius from its center at the easterly most point of the headwaters of the main stem of Cascade Creek, said end line shall be bounded by said circle, concave southwesterly, as designated under Public Law 109-44.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying outside the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet southerly of the southerly ordinary high water line of the main stem of Cascade Creek and the arc of latitude at 46° 10' 40.6" N. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following nine courses:

- 1) North 26° 22' East, 2087 feet;
- 2) North 43° 12' East, 1940 feet;
- 3) North 53° 16' East, 1257 feet;
- 4) North 48° 00' East, 447 feet, more or less, to the line 660 feet southerly of said Cascade Creek;
- 5) North 63° 03' East, along said line, 1695 feet, more or less, to the circle with a radius of 660 feet and the center at the northeasterly most point of the headwaters of said Cascade Creek;
- 6) northerly, along said circle concave to the southwest, 2073 feet, more or less, to the line 660 feet northerly of the centerline of said Cascade Creek;
- 7) South 62° 57' West, along said line, 1593 feet;
- 8) South 55° 28' West, 3409 feet;

- 9) South 73° 24' West, 460 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet northerly of the northerly ordinary high water line of said Cascade Creek.

ALSO EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying westerly of the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of the main stem of Cascade Creek and the arc of latitude at 46° 10' 35.4" N. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following fifteen courses:

- 1) South 06° 02' East, 600 feet;
- 2) South 00° 31' West, 608 feet;
- 3) South 19° 23' East, 378 feet;
- 4) South 13° 02' West, 371 feet;
- 5) South 42° 14' West, 825 feet;
- 6) South 23° 56' West, 575 feet;
- 7) South 09° 40' East, 702 feet;
- 8) South 00° 54' West, 1143 feet;
- 9) South 06° 52' West, 2088 feet;
- 10) South 10° 23' East, 756 feet;
- 11) South 17° 30' West, 1314 feet;
- 12) South 81° 05' West, 566 feet;
- 13) South 46° 34' West, 1764 feet;
- 14) South 26° 02' West, 960 feet; and
- 15) South 31° 01' West, 1530 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of said Cascade Creek.

ALSO EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying easterly of the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet easterly of the easterly ordinary high water line of the main stem of Cascade Creek and the arc of latitude at 46° 09' 31.4" N. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following twelve courses:

- 1) South 15° 44' West, 1215 feet;
- 2) South 10° 53' West, 1485 feet;
- 3) South 56° 11' West, 1031 feet;
- 4) South 49° 07' West, 649 feet;
- 5) South 55° 14' West, 594 feet;
- 6) South 41° 12' West, 784 feet;
- 7) South 09° 15' West, 1015 feet;
- 8) South 22° 07' West, 661 feet;
- 9) South 04° 36' West, 349 feet;

- 10) South $31^{\circ} 09'$ West, 920 feet;

- 12) South $04^{\circ} 09'$ East, 1354 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet
easterly of the easterly ordinary high water line of said Cascade Creek.

The area described, comprising all of Parcel "B", contains 1548 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 6.6 miles of the Cascade Creek. The bearings shown herein are geodetic, referenced to the true meridian, NAD 83 (2011).

Parcel "C" – Scenic Segment: "The approximately 1.5-mile segment of Cascade Creek from the Mount Adams Wilderness boundary downstream to its confluence with the White Salmon River as a scenic river." (Public Law 109-44)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the main stem of the Cascade Creek, situated in the state of Washington, County of Skamania, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington

T. 7 N., R. 10 E.,
secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at the line 1320 feet easterly of the easterly ordinary high water line of the main stem of the White Salmon River and to end at the true boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness, and the end lines shall be bounded by the same, as designated under Public Law 109-44.

The area described, comprising all of Parcel "C", contains 444 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 1.5 miles of the Cascade Creek.

Parcel "D" – Scenic Segment: "The approximately 11.8-mile segment of the main stem of the White Salmon River from the Mount Adams Wilderness boundary downstream to the Gifford Pinchot National Forest boundary as a scenic river." (Public Law 109-44)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the main stem of the White Salmon River, situated in the state of Washington, County of Skamania, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington

- T. 7 N., R. 9 E., unsurveyed.
sec. 2;
protraction blocks 37, 38, and 39.
- T. 7 N., R. 10 E.,
secs. 6, 7, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 27, 28, 29, 33, and 34.
- T. 8 N., R. 9 E., unsurveyed.
secs. 13, 26, and 35;
protraction blocks 37, 38, and 39.
- T. 8 N., R. 10 E., unsurveyed.
sec. 18;
protraction block 41.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at the true boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness and to end at the true southerly boundary of T. 7 N., R. 10 E., W.M., being the Gifford Pinchot National Forest boundary, and the end lines shall be bounded by the same, as designated under Public Law 109-44.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying northerly of the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of a line 600 feet northerly of centerline of the main stem of the White Salmon River and the westerly boundary of the Mount Adams Wilderness. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following eight courses:

- 1) South 74° 00' West, 441 feet;
- 2) South 65° 39' West, 1219 feet;
- 3) South 43° 28' West, 311 feet;
- 4) South 46° 22' West, 372 feet;
- 5) South 50° 51' West, 404 feet;
- 6) South 63° 05' West, 377 feet;
- 7) South 19° 47' West, 638 feet; and
- 8) South 64° 19' West, 401 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet northerly of the northerly ordinary high water line of the main stem of the White Salmon River.

ALSO, adding to said strip, two parcels more particularly described as follows:

- 1) A parcel of land situated in sections 26, 35, protraction blocks 38, and 39 of unsurveyed T. 8 N., R. 9 E., W.M., and in section 2 and protraction block 37 of unsurveyed T. 7 N., R. 9 E., W.M., bounded to the east said strip, and bounded to the west, north and south by the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of the main stem of the White Salmon River and the arc of latitude at $46^{\circ} 09' 14.65''$ N. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following five courses:

- 1) South $17^{\circ} 11'$ West, 3378 feet;
- 2) South $20^{\circ} 35'$ West, 2053 feet;
- 3) South $00^{\circ} 31'$ East, 2124 feet;
- 4) South $38^{\circ} 35'$ East, 741 feet; and
- 5) South $45^{\circ} 26'$ East, 1999 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of said White Salmon River.

- 2) A parcel of land situated in protraction block 39 of unsurveyed T. 8 N., R. 9 E., W.M., in protraction block 37 of unsurveyed T. 7 N., R. 9 E., W.M., and in section 6 of T. 7 N., R. 10 E., W.M., bounded to the west said strip, and bounded to the east, north and south by the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of the main stem of the White Salmon River and the arc of latitude at $46^{\circ} 08' 20.2''$ N. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following fourteen courses:

- 1) South $29^{\circ} 56'$ East, 1603 feet;
- 2) South $37^{\circ} 19'$ East, 653 feet;
- 3) South $52^{\circ} 30'$ East, 397 feet;
- 4) North $87^{\circ} 20'$ East, 230 feet;
- 5) North $65^{\circ} 13'$ East, 212 feet;
- 6) South $25^{\circ} 03'$ West, 500 feet;
- 7) South $04^{\circ} 49'$ West, 169 feet;
- 8) South $20^{\circ} 47'$ East, 259 feet;
- 9) South $48^{\circ} 18'$ East, 269 feet;
- 10) South $20^{\circ} 19'$ East, 296 feet;
- 11) South $01^{\circ} 50'$ East, 1690 feet;
- 12) South $31^{\circ} 27'$ West, 317 feet;
- 13) South $19^{\circ} 05'$ East, 393 feet; and
- 14) South $42^{\circ} 55'$ West, 340 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet easterly of the easterly ordinary high water line of said White Salmon River.

The area described, comprising all of Parcel "D", contains 4173 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 12.1 miles of the main stem of the White Salmon River. The bearings shown herein are geodetic, referenced to the true meridian, NAD 83 (2011).

The area described, comprising all of Parcels "A", "B", "C", and "D", contains 6585 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 14.5 miles of the main stem of the White Salmon River and 8.1 miles of the Cascade Creek.
