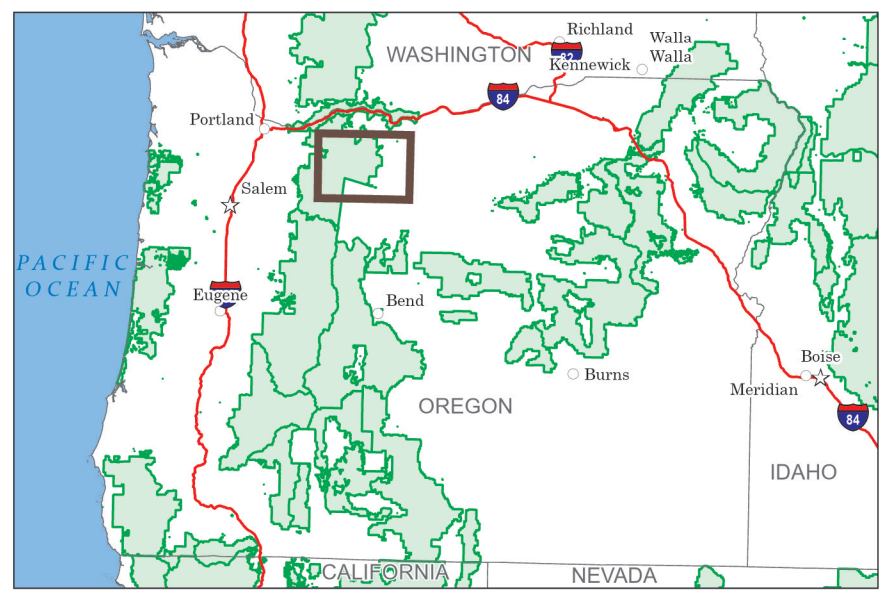

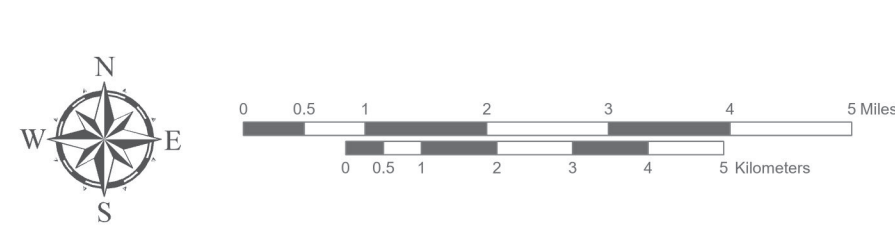

MOTOR VEHICLE USE MAP (MVUM)
